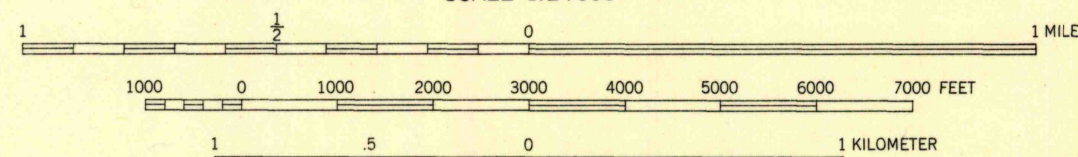

north zone

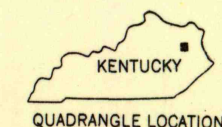
