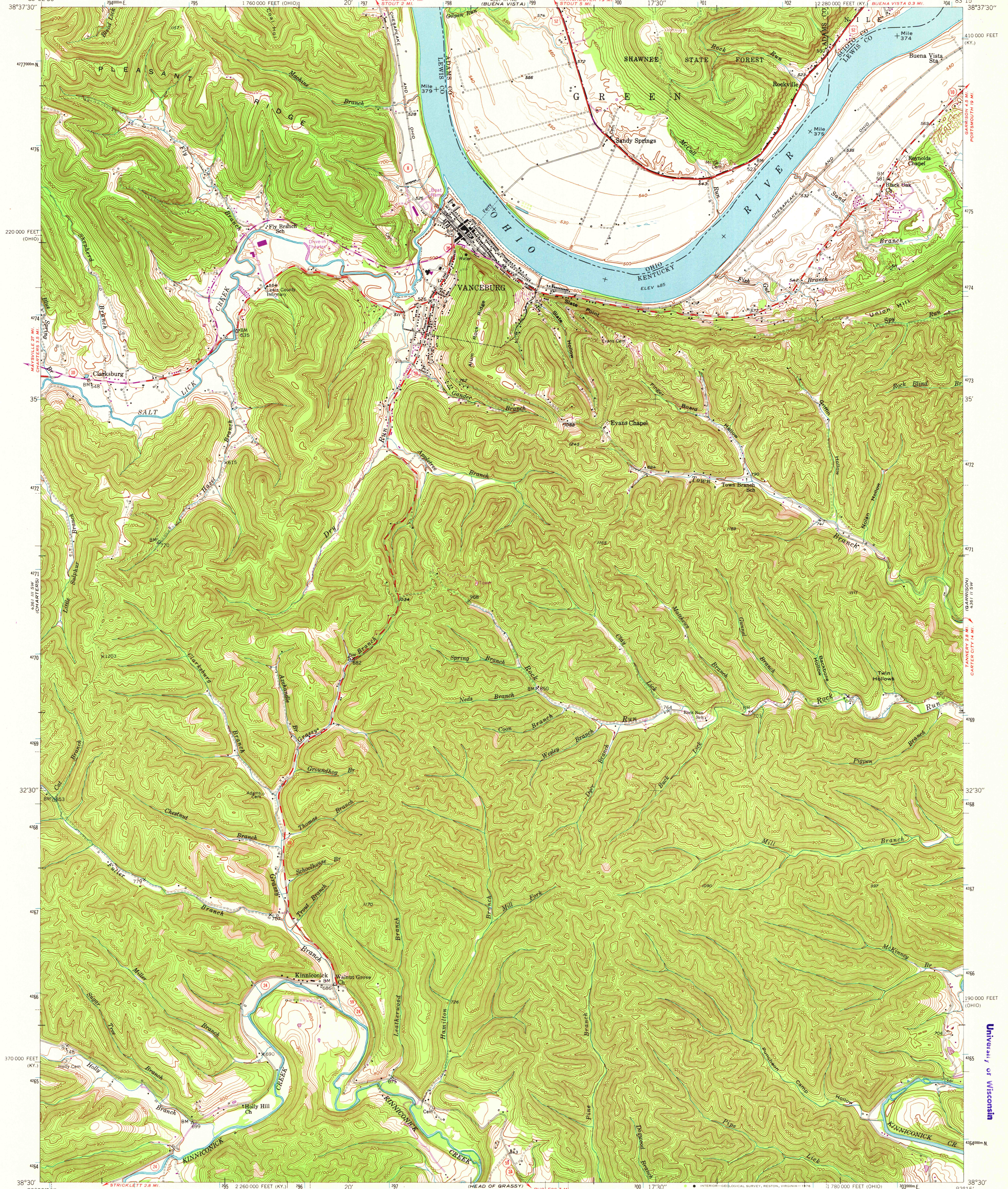


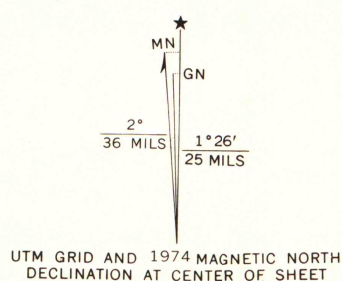

SE/4 VANCEBURG 15 QUADRANGLE

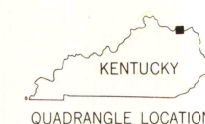
