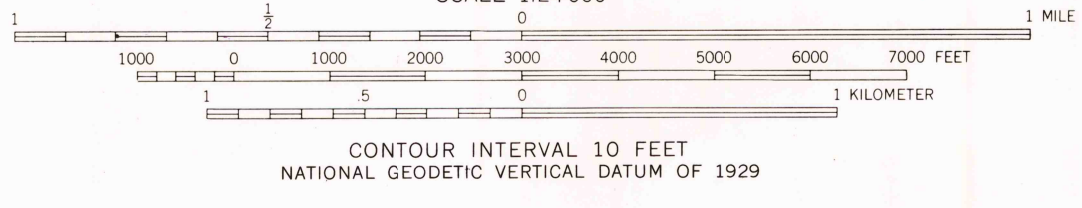
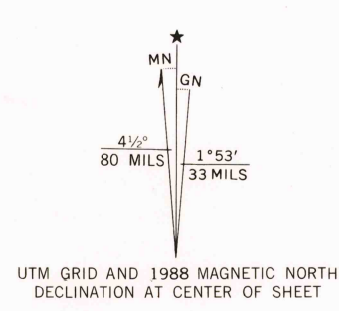

Polyconic projection, 10,000-foot grid ticks based on Ohio coordinate system, south zone, 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 16, shown in blue. 1927 North American Datum to place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 2 meters south and 6 meters west as shown by dashed corner ticks. Red tint indicates areas in which only landmark buildings are shown. Areas covered by dashed light-blue pattern are subject to controlled inundation. Entire area lies within the Between the Miamis. Land lines based on the Great Miami River Base. There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the National or State reservations shown on this map.
