
Topography by photogrammetric methods from aerial photographs taken 1952. Field checked 1960

Polyconic projection. 10,000-foot grid ticks based on Ohio coordinate system, north zone. 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 17, shown in blue 1927 North American Datum. To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 2 meters south and 14 meters west as shown by dashed corner ticks

Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where generally visible on aerial photographs. This information is unchecked

Red tint indicates area in which only landmark buildings are shown. Entire area lies within the Connecticut Western Reserve. Land lines established by private subdivision of the Connecticut Western Reserve. There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the National or State reservations shown on this map
