


To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 3 meters south and 14 meters west as shown by dashed corner ticks.
Areas covered by dashed light-blue pattern are subject to controlled inundation by Dover Dam.
Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where generally visible on aerial photographs. This information is uncheck.
Red tint indicates areas in which only landmark buildings are shown.
Land lines within the Old Seven Ranges based on the Ohio River Base Line within the United States Military District based on the Base Line of the United States Military District. Dotted land lines indicate private subdivision of the Dohrman Grant.
