

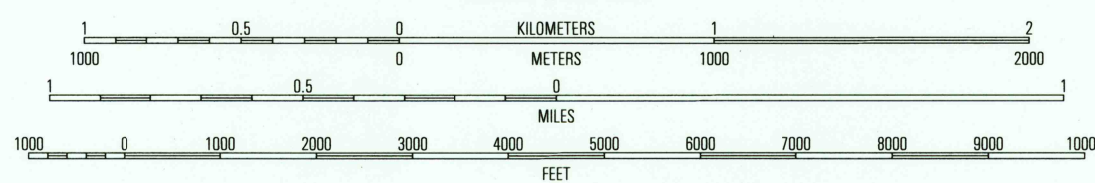
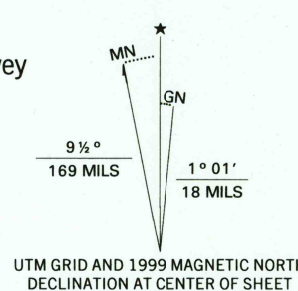

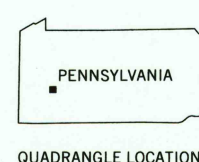
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid, zone 17
