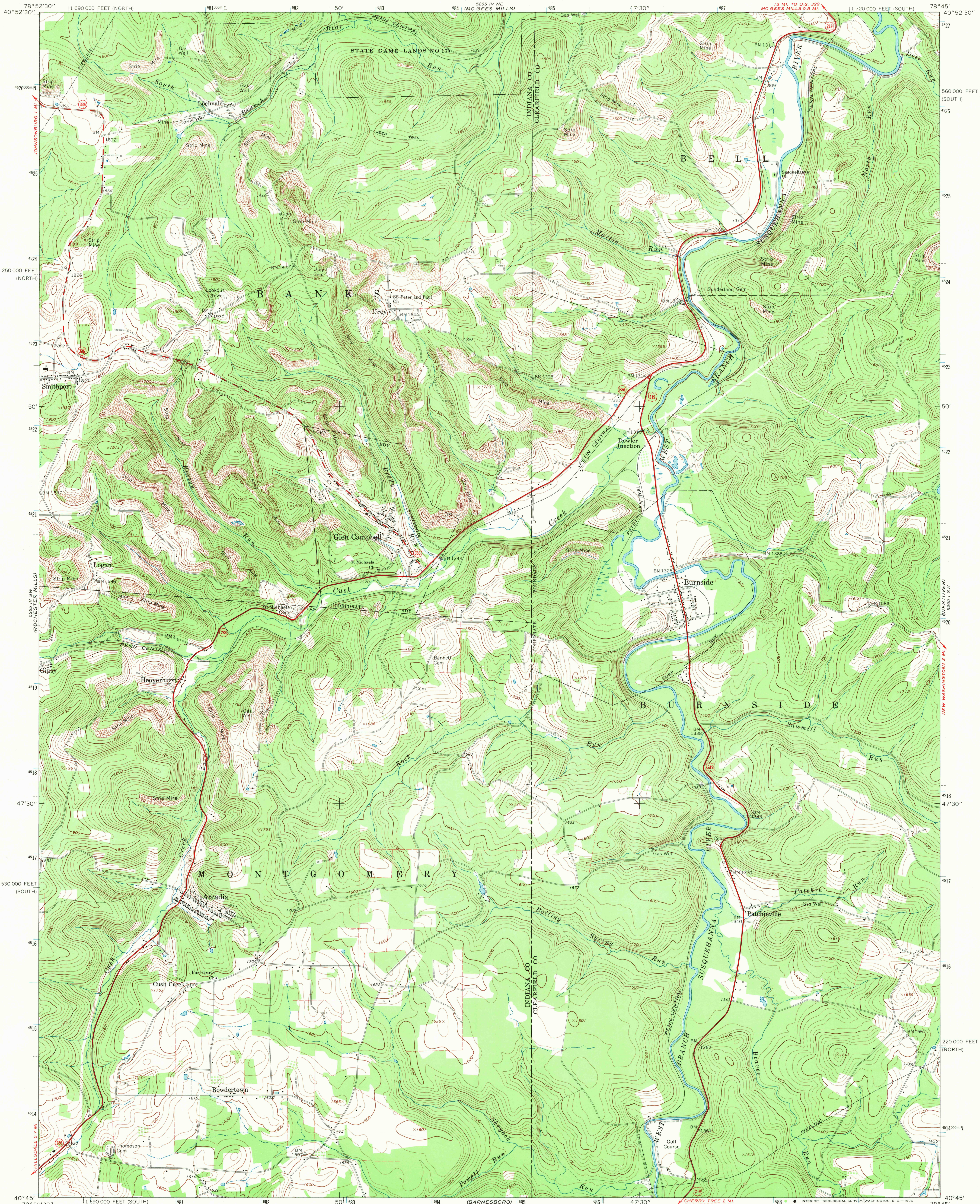

SE/4 PUNXSUTAWNEY 15' QUADRANGLE

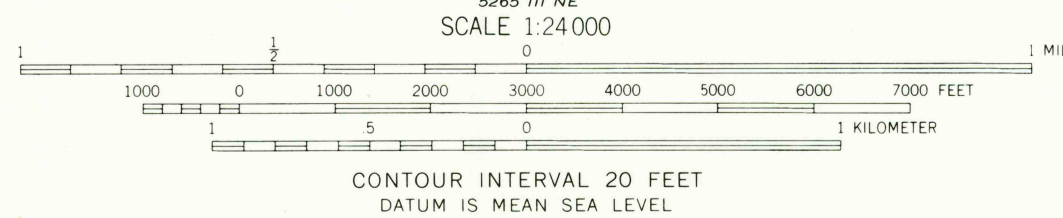

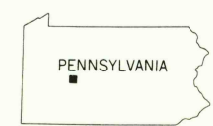
