Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum

10,000-foot grid based on Pennsylvania coordinate system,

south zone

1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks,

zone 17, shown in blue

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983

move the projection lines 3 meters south and 17 meters west

as shown by dashed corner ticks

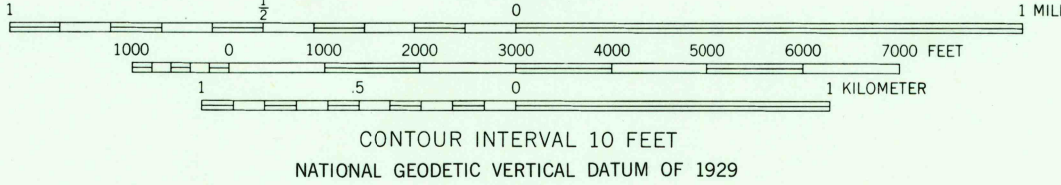
Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where

Contours in strip mine areas may not accurately represent present topography

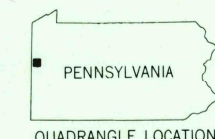
