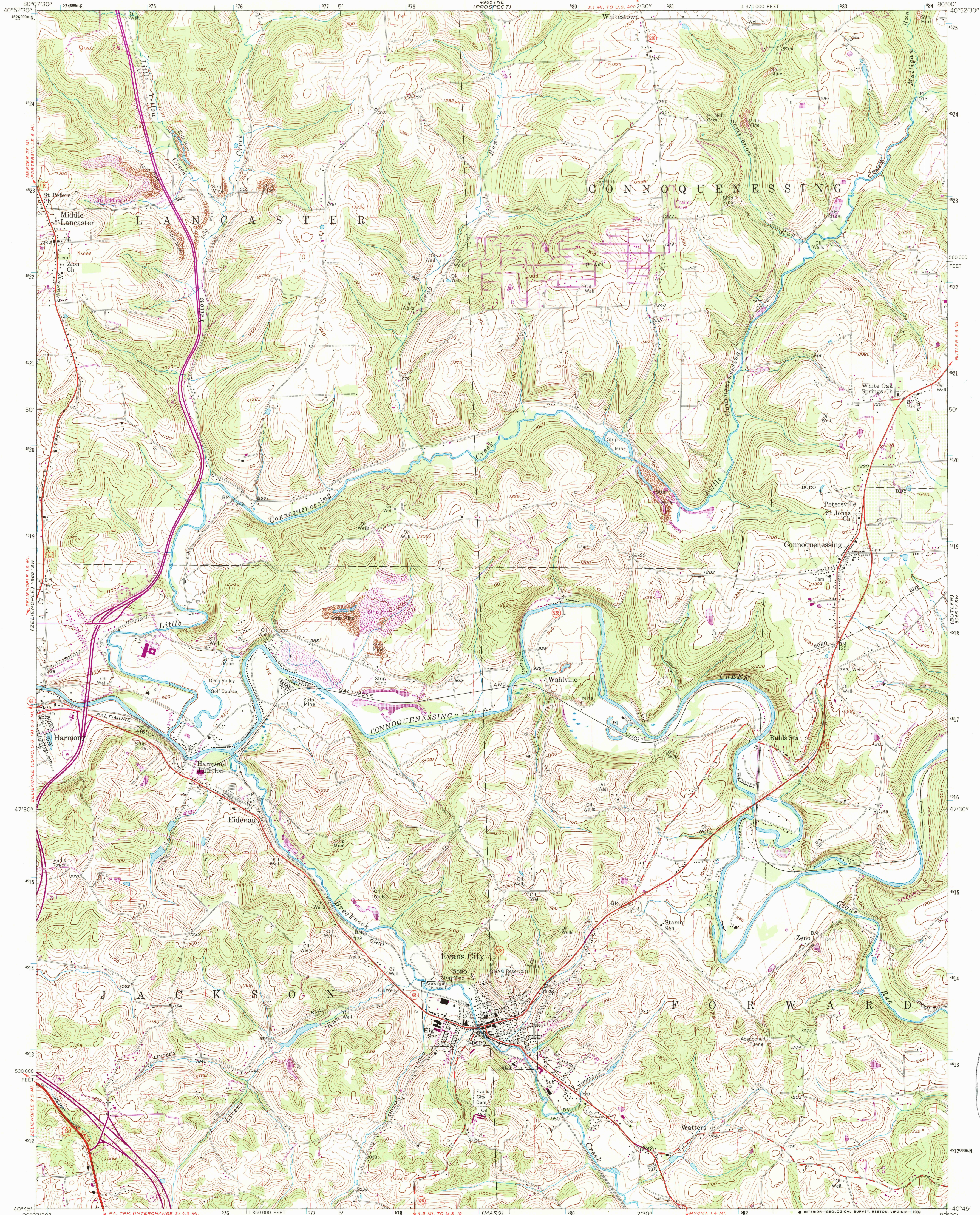

zone 17, shown in blue

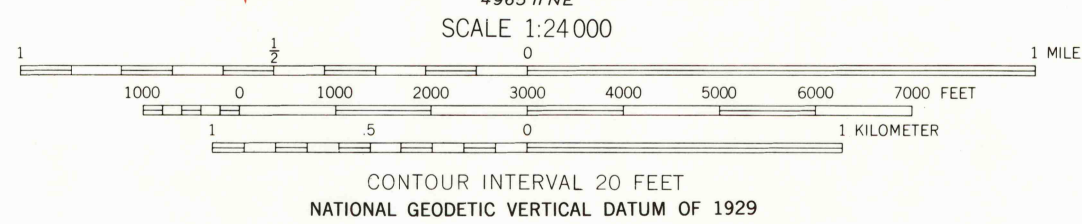
Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines

Contours in strip mine areas compiled from 1952 photography

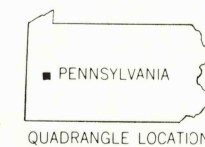
