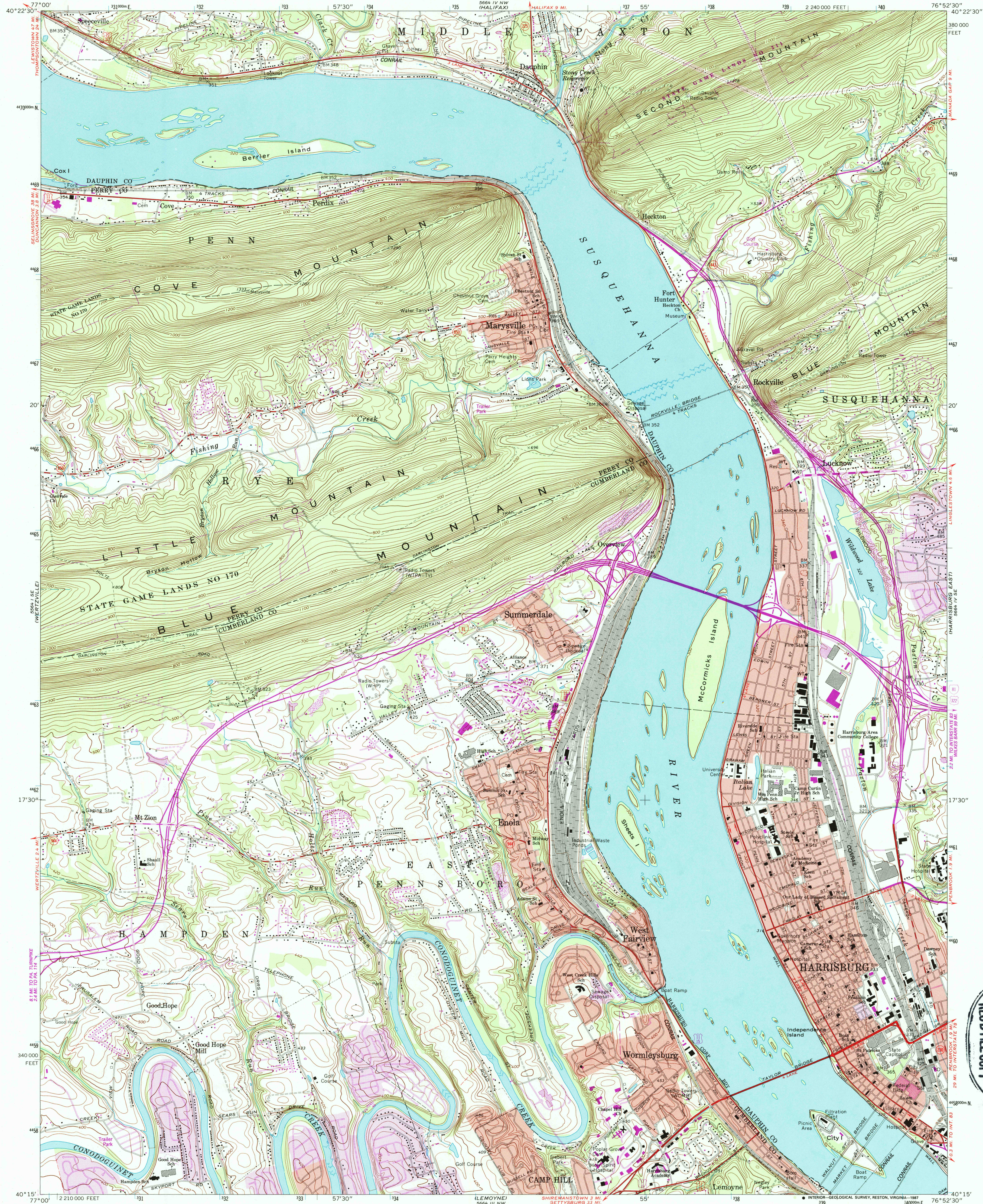

the National or State reservations shown on this map

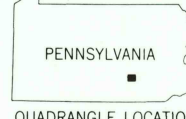
