

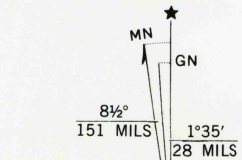

Photom imagery rectified by automatic correlation



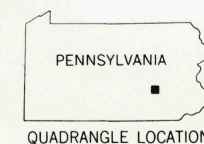
UTM GRID AND 1977 MAGNETIC NORTH
