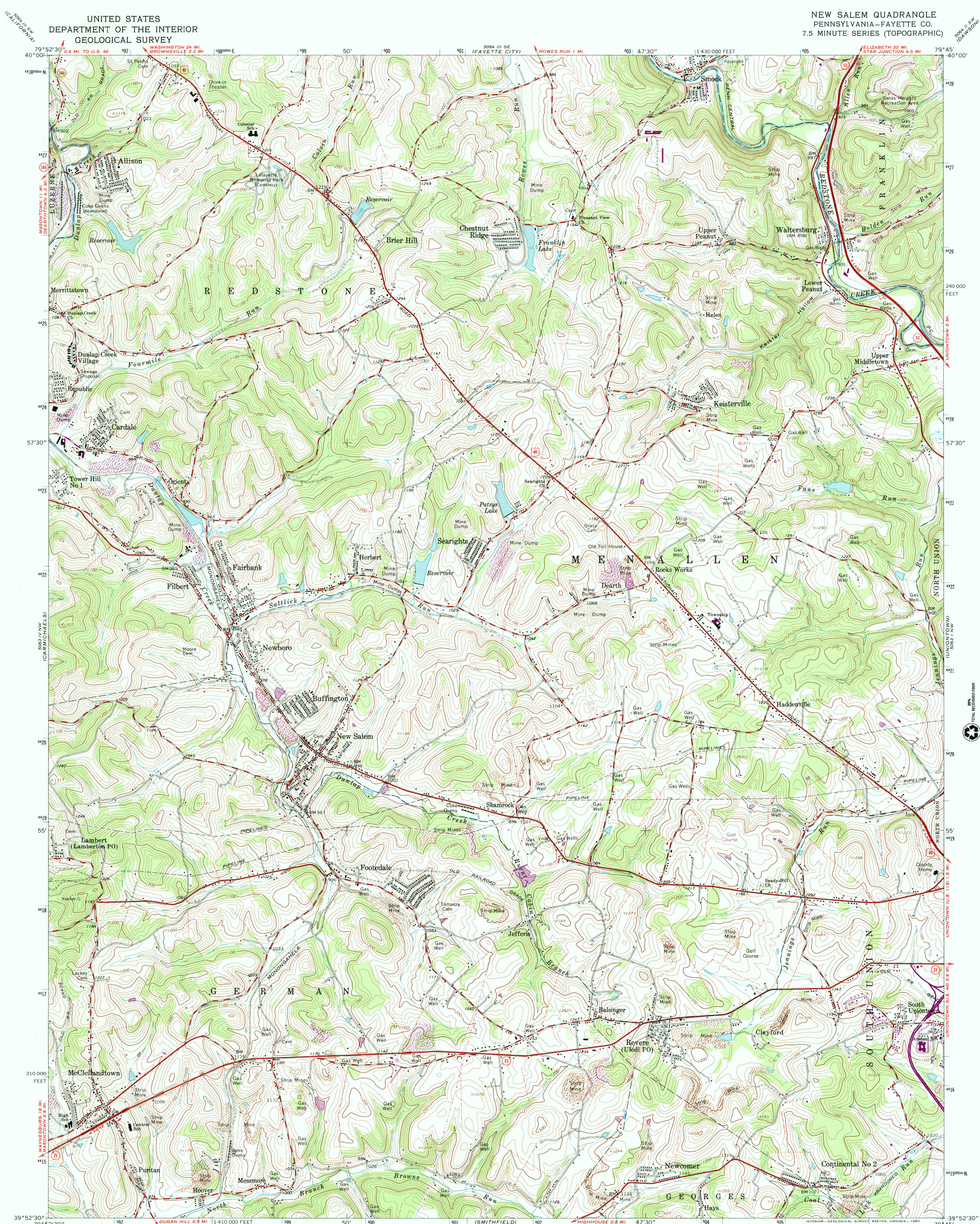

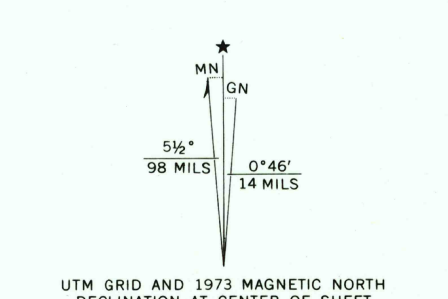

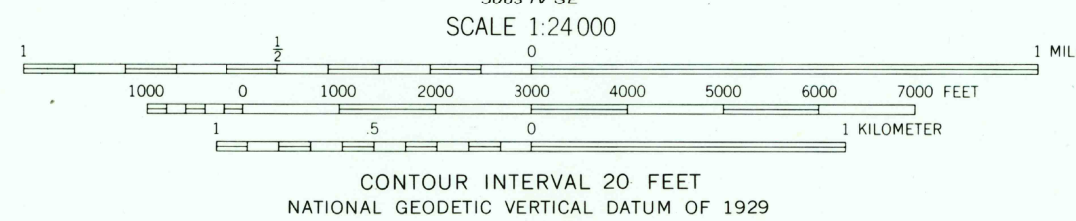
Polyconic projection. 10,000-foot grid ticks based on

generally visible on aerial photographs. This information is unchecked

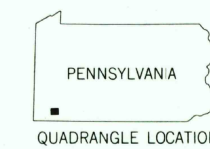
