


To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983  
move the projection lines 5 meters south and  
4 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks  
Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines  
where generally visible on aerial photographs. This information is unchecked  
Red tint indicates areas in which only landmark buildings are shown  
There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of  
the National or State reservations shown on this map
