


To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 3 meters north and 50 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks.
Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence lines. Where omitted, land lines have not been established. There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the National or State reservations shown on this map.
