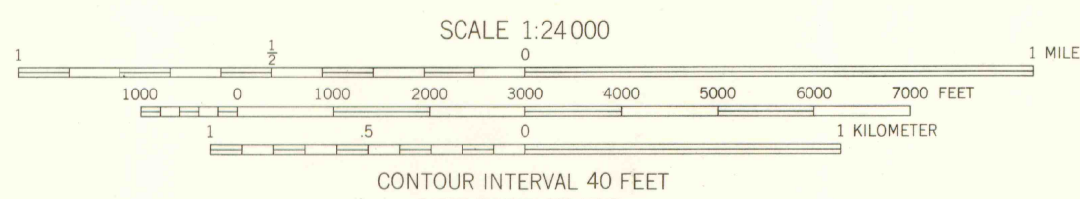

because of insufficient data

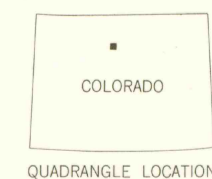
