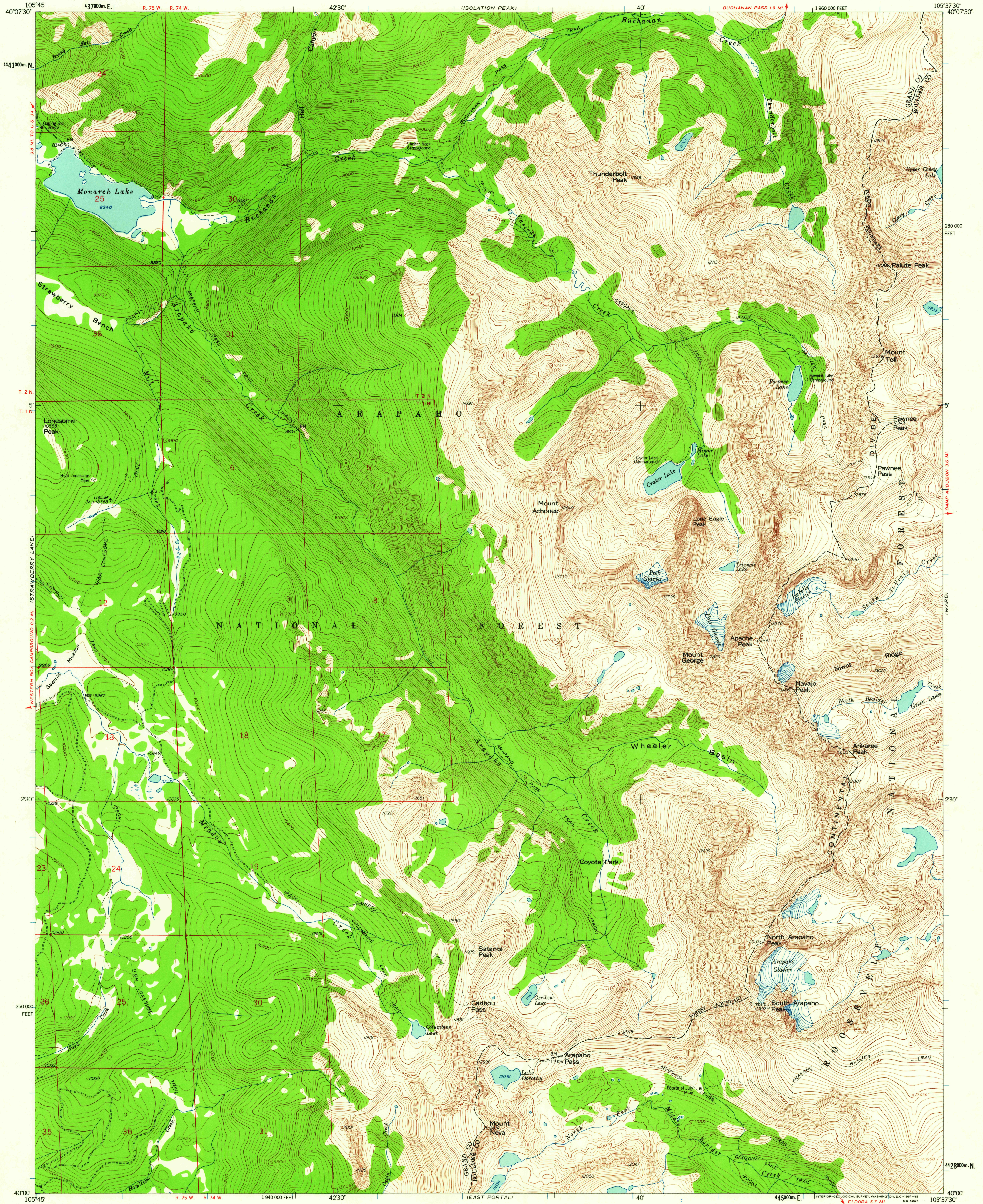

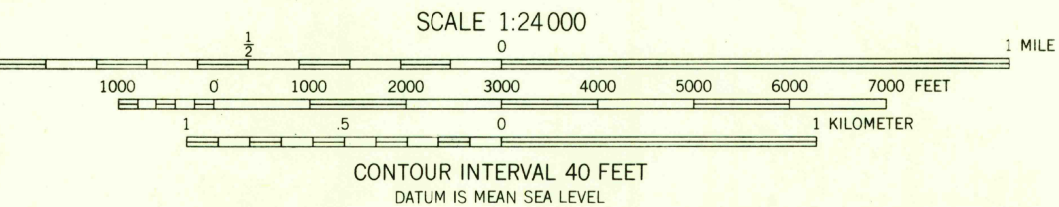

Dashed land lines indicate approximate locations Certain land lines omitted in T. 1 and 2 N. R. 74 W. because of insufficient data

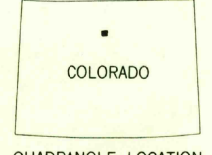
