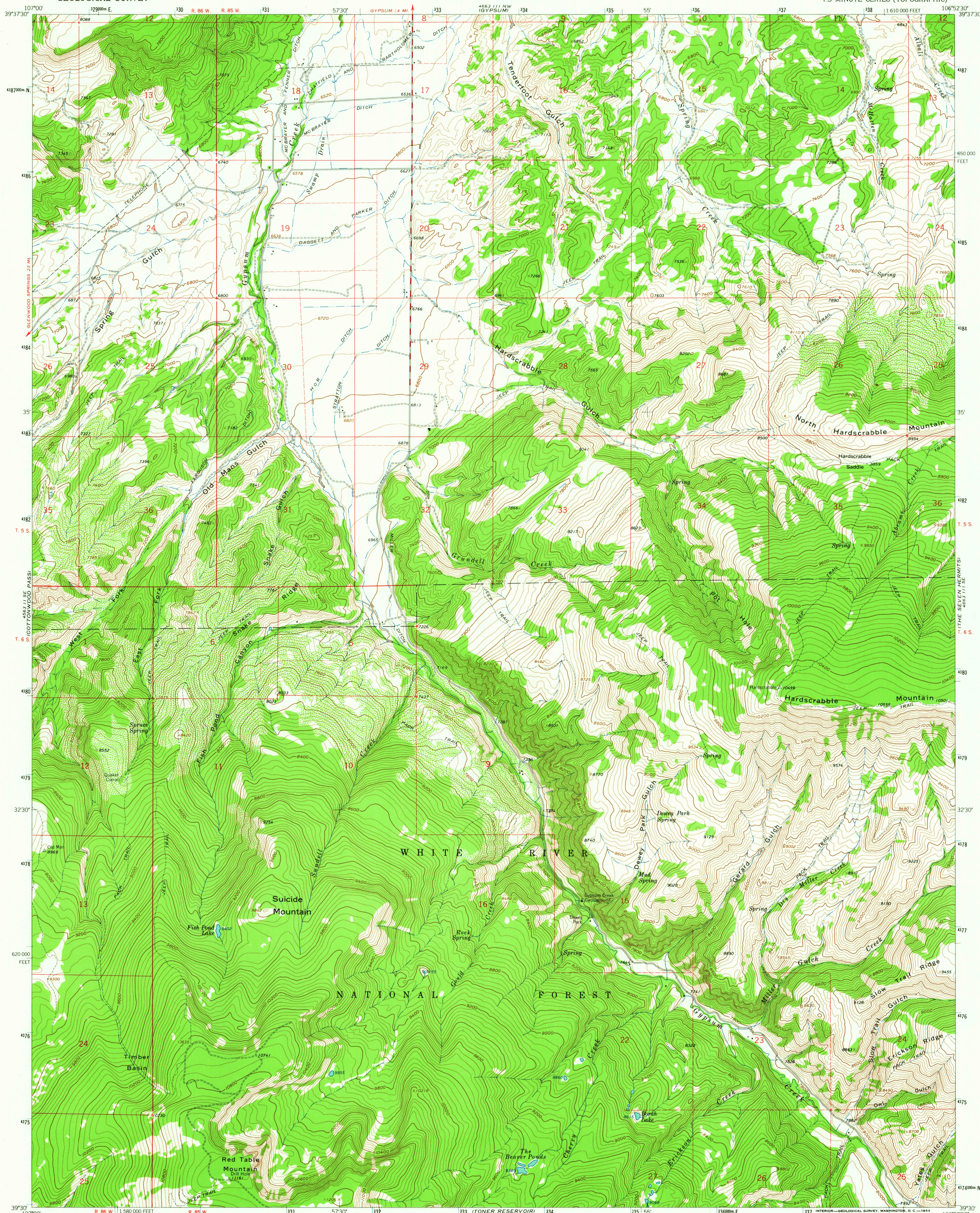

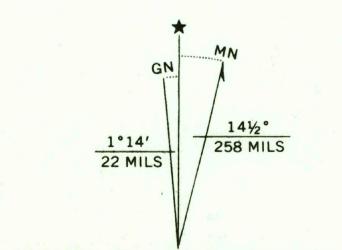

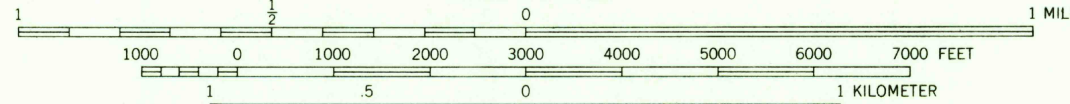
Polycyclic projection. 1927 North American datum

Where omitted, land lines have not been established

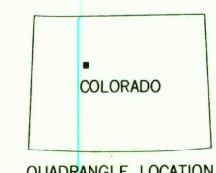
