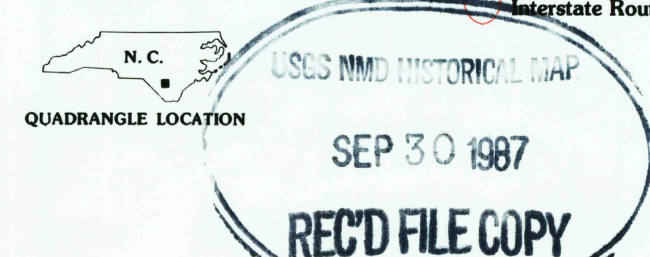
EMERSON QUADRANGLE
