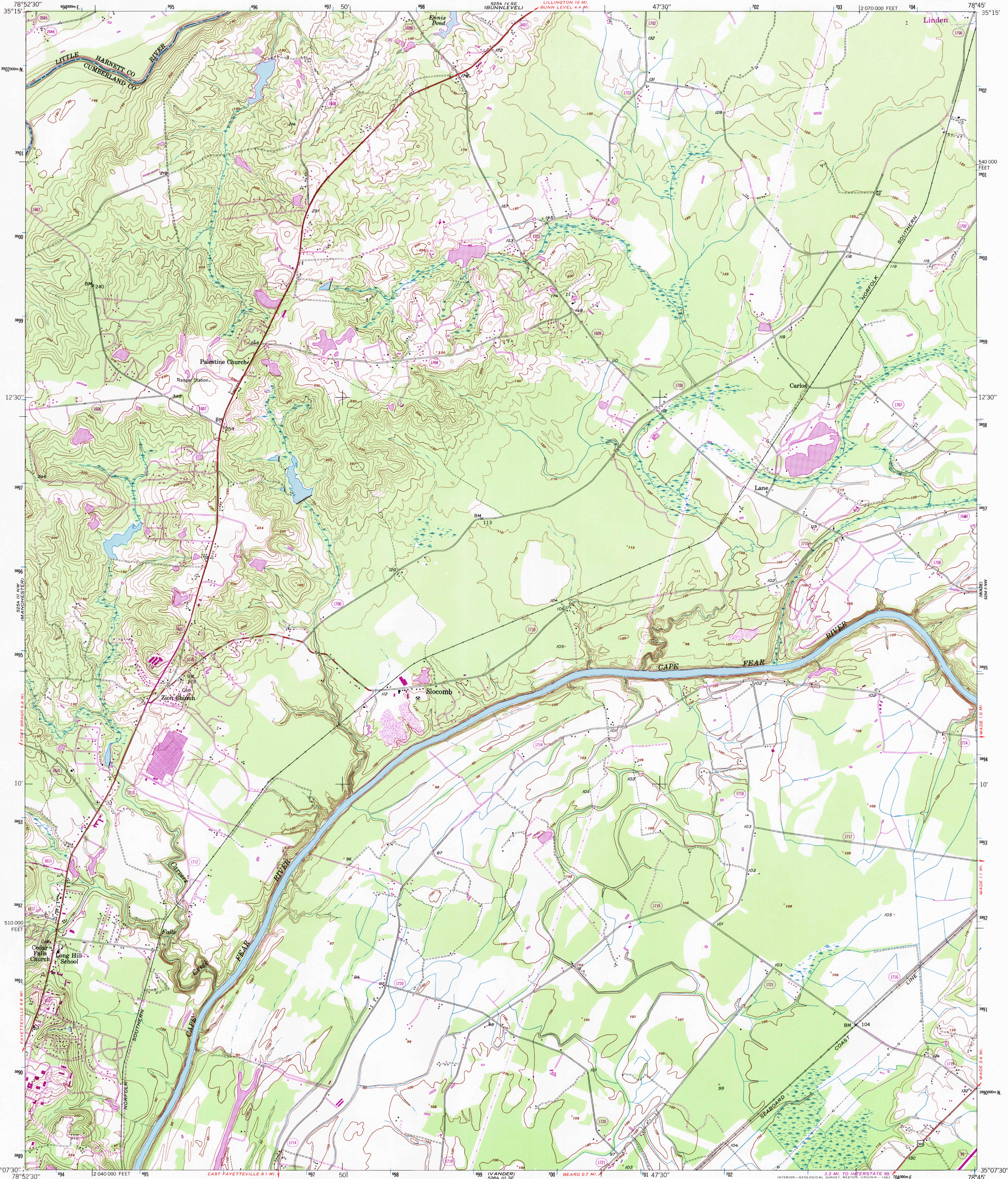

NE4 FAYETTEVILLE 15' QUADRANGLE

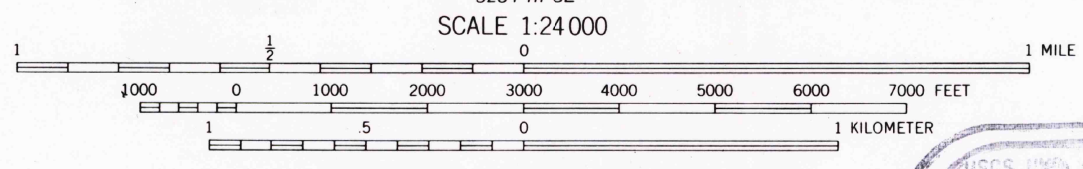
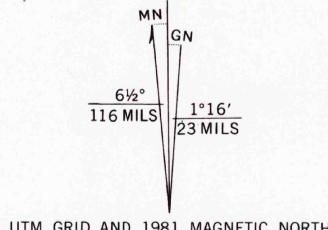

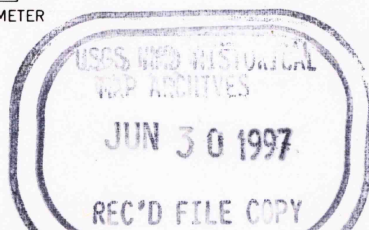
