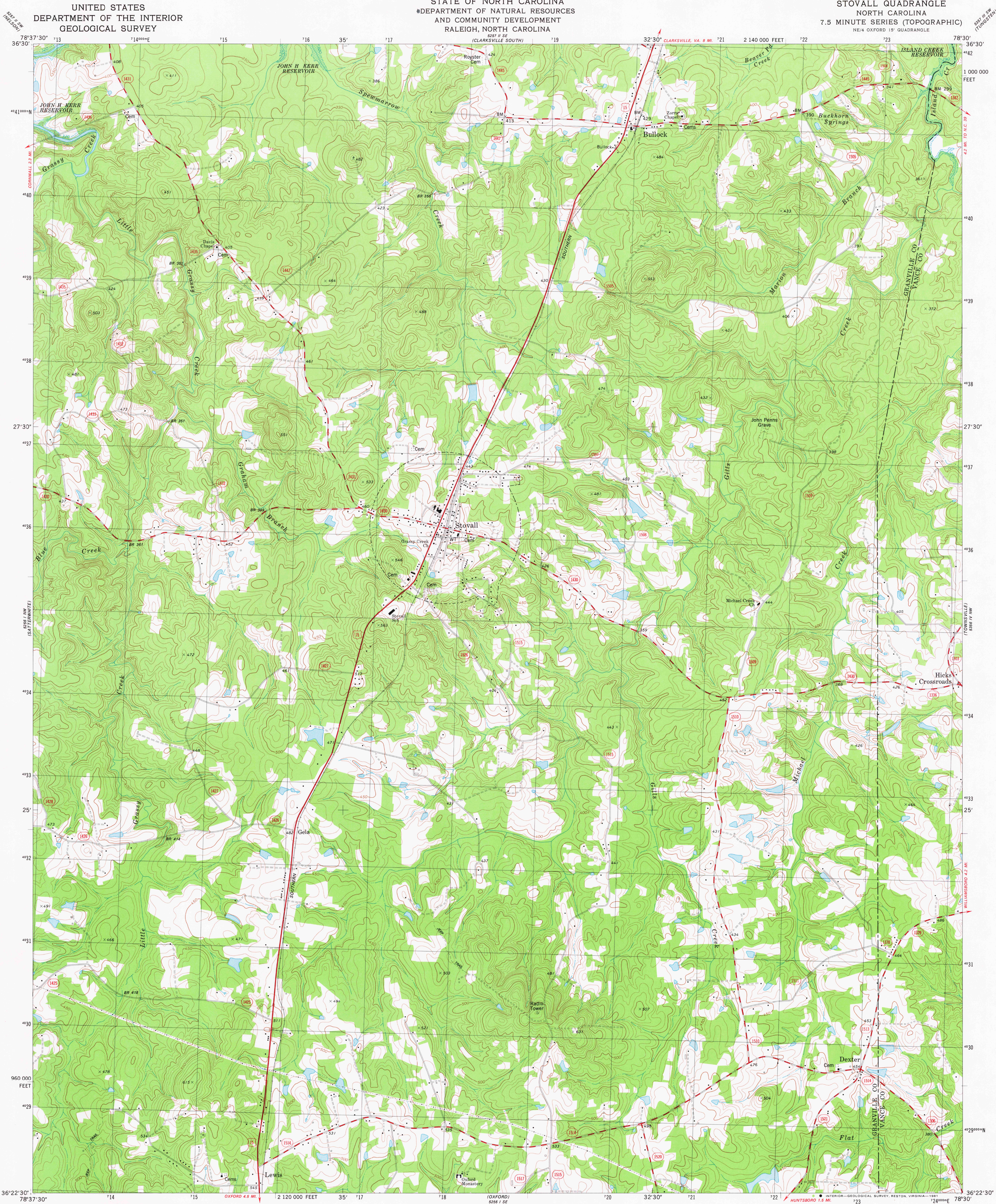

NE/4 OXFORD 15' QUADRANGLE

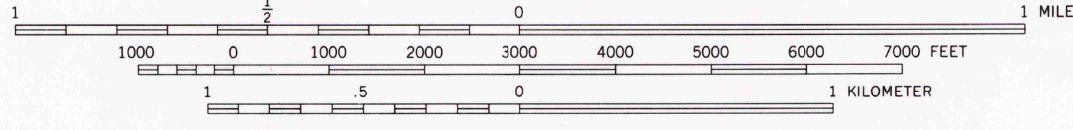
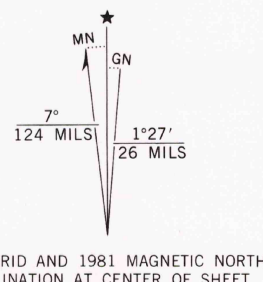
