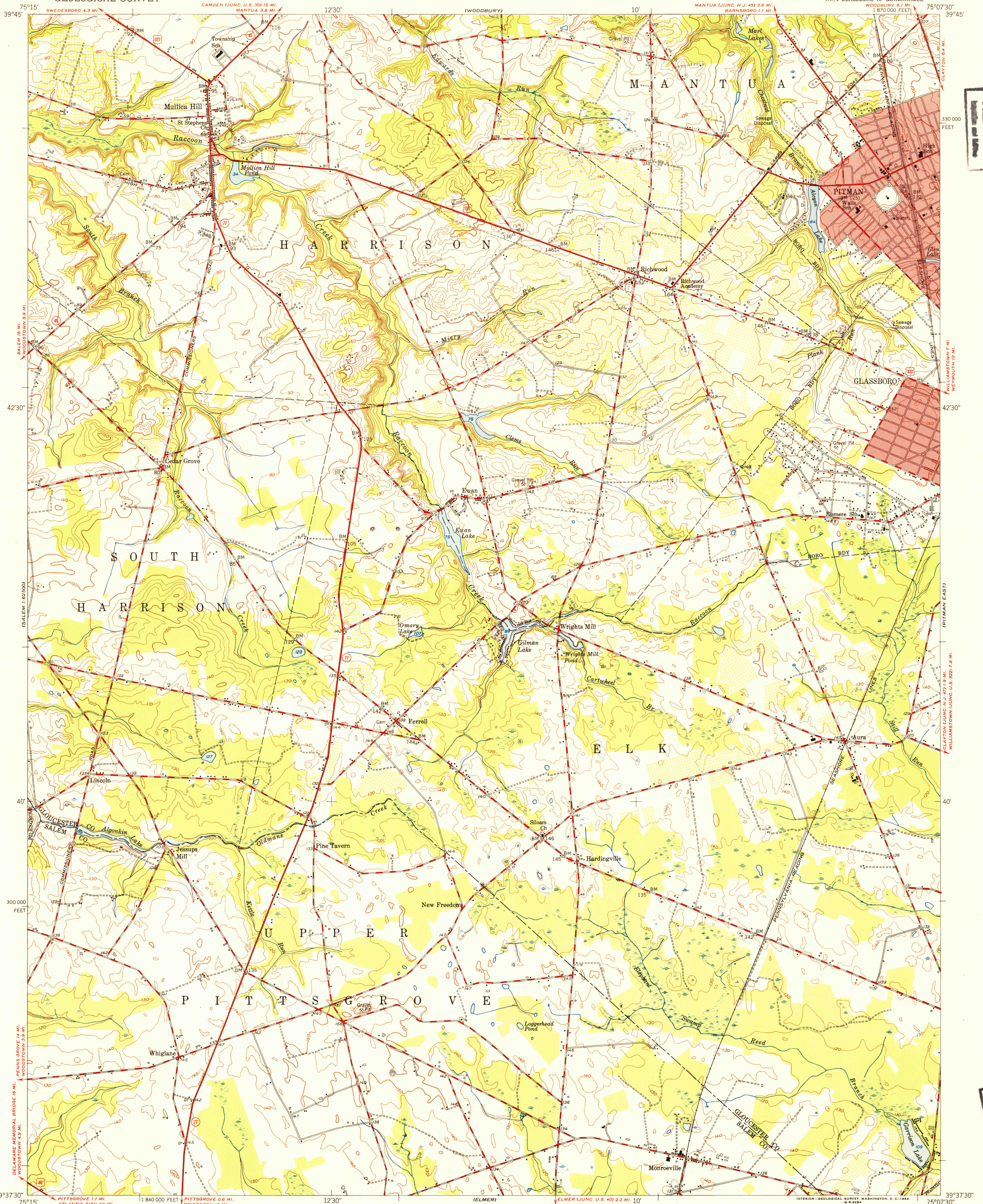

NW/4 GLASSBORO 15' QUADRANGLE

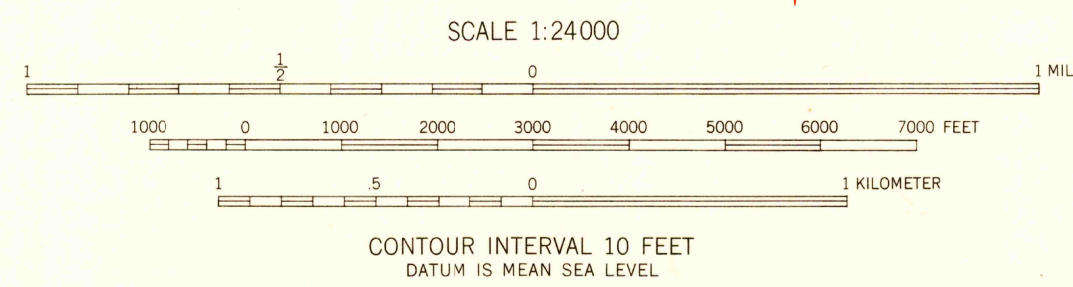
