

Polyconic projection, 1927 North American datum 10,000-foot grid based on Montana coordinate system, south zone. 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 12, shown in blue. Dashed land lines indicate approximate locations. To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 9 meters north and 58 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks.
