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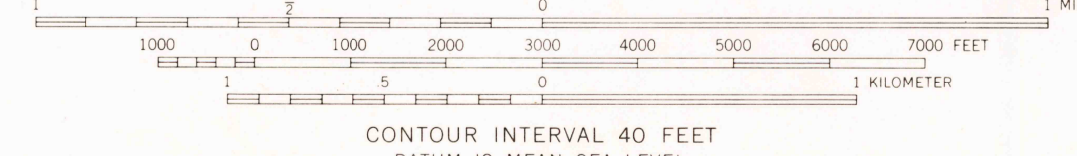
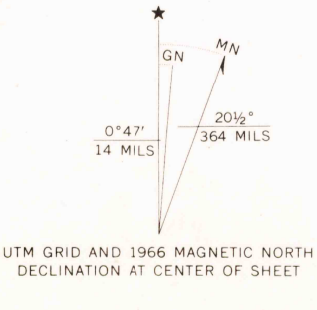

10,000-foot grids based on Montana coordinate system, north and central zones

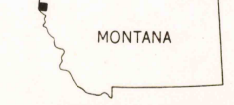
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 11, shown in blue
