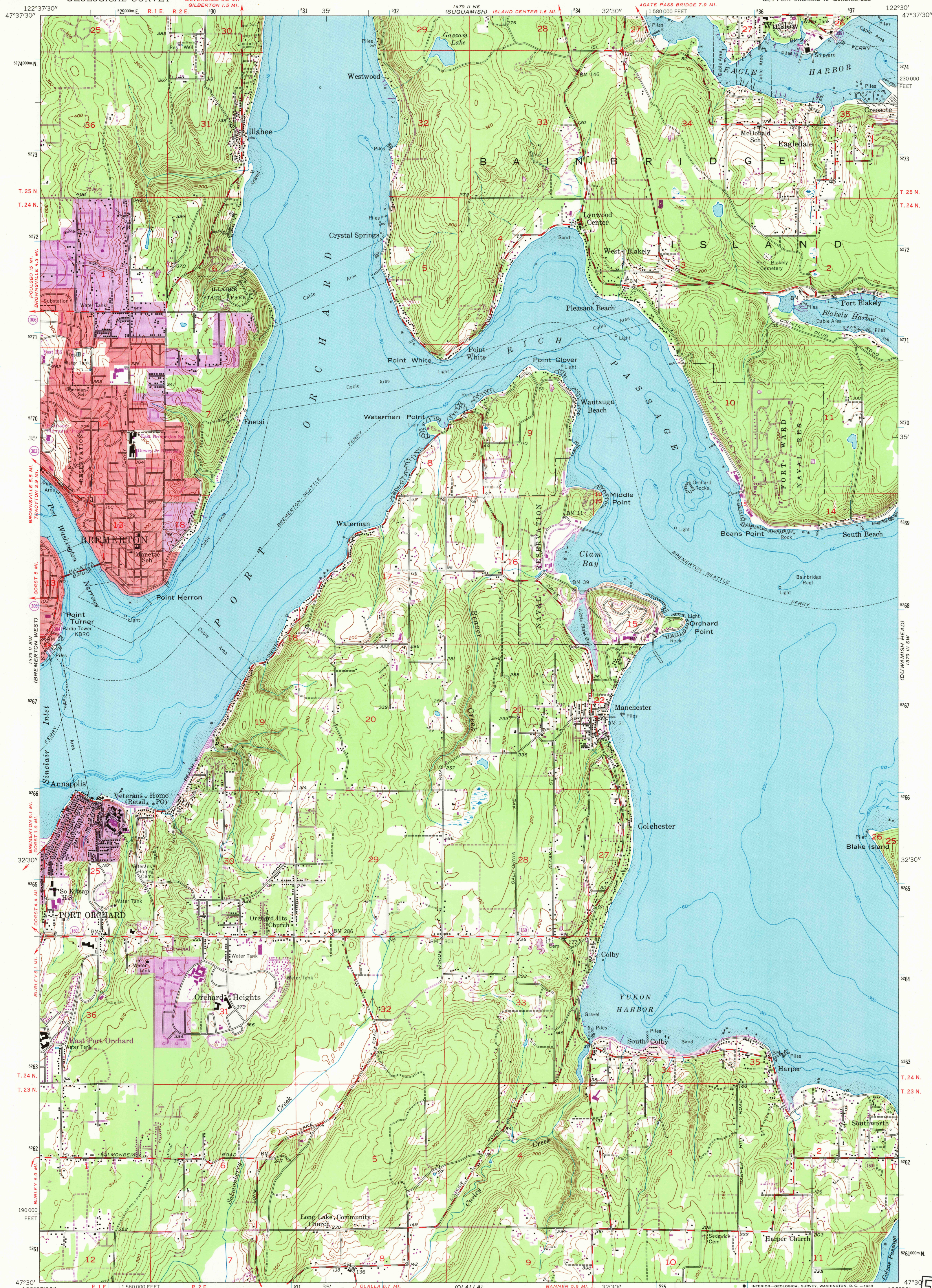

10,000-foot grid based on Washington coordinate system, north zone

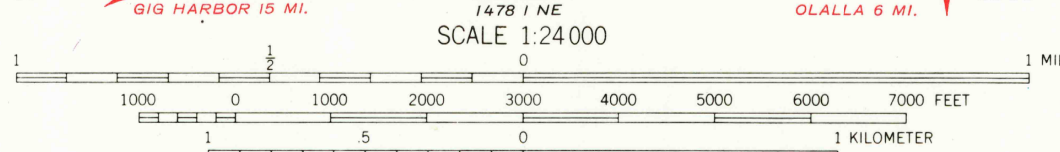
Red tint indicates areas in which only landmark buildings are shown
