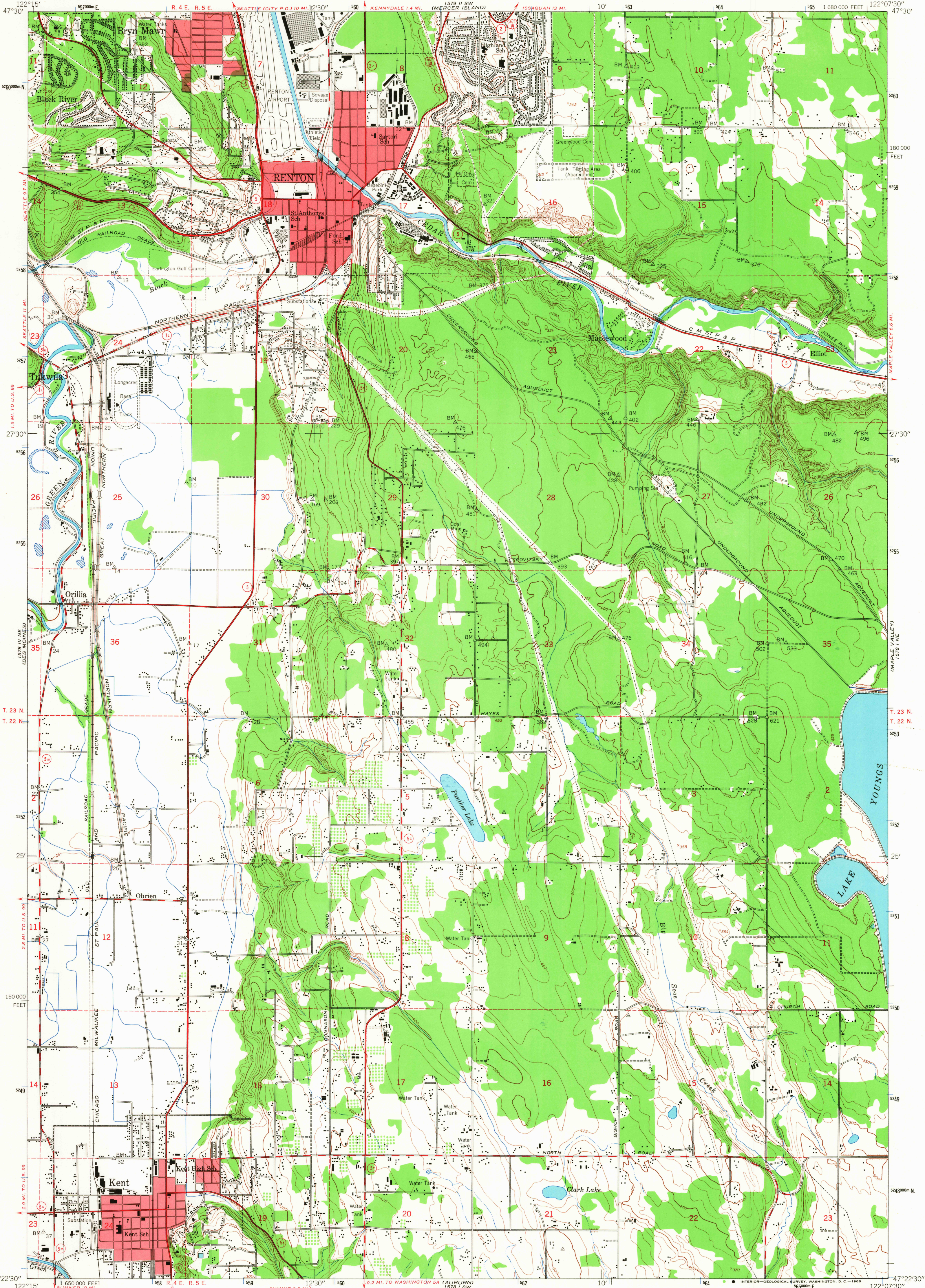

10,000-foot grid based on Washington coordinate system, north zone

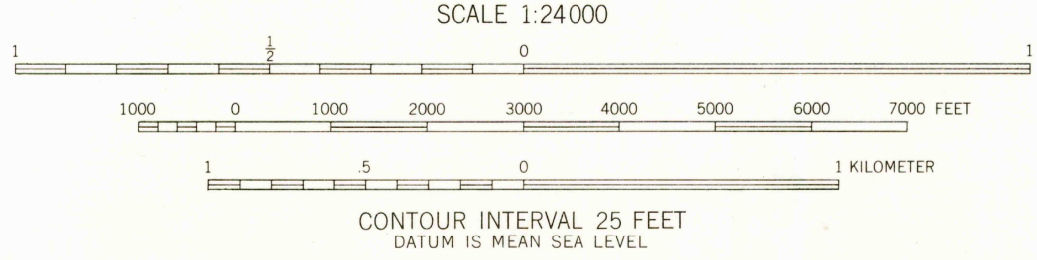
Red tint indicates areas in which only landmark buildings are shown

Unchecked elevations are shown in brown

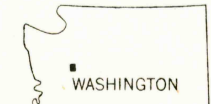
Dashed land lines indicate approximate locations
