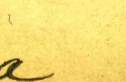
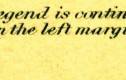
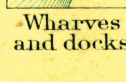
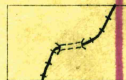
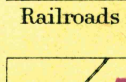
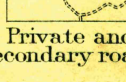
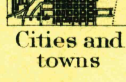
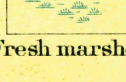
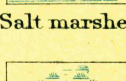
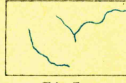
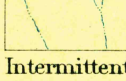
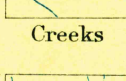


Contours
