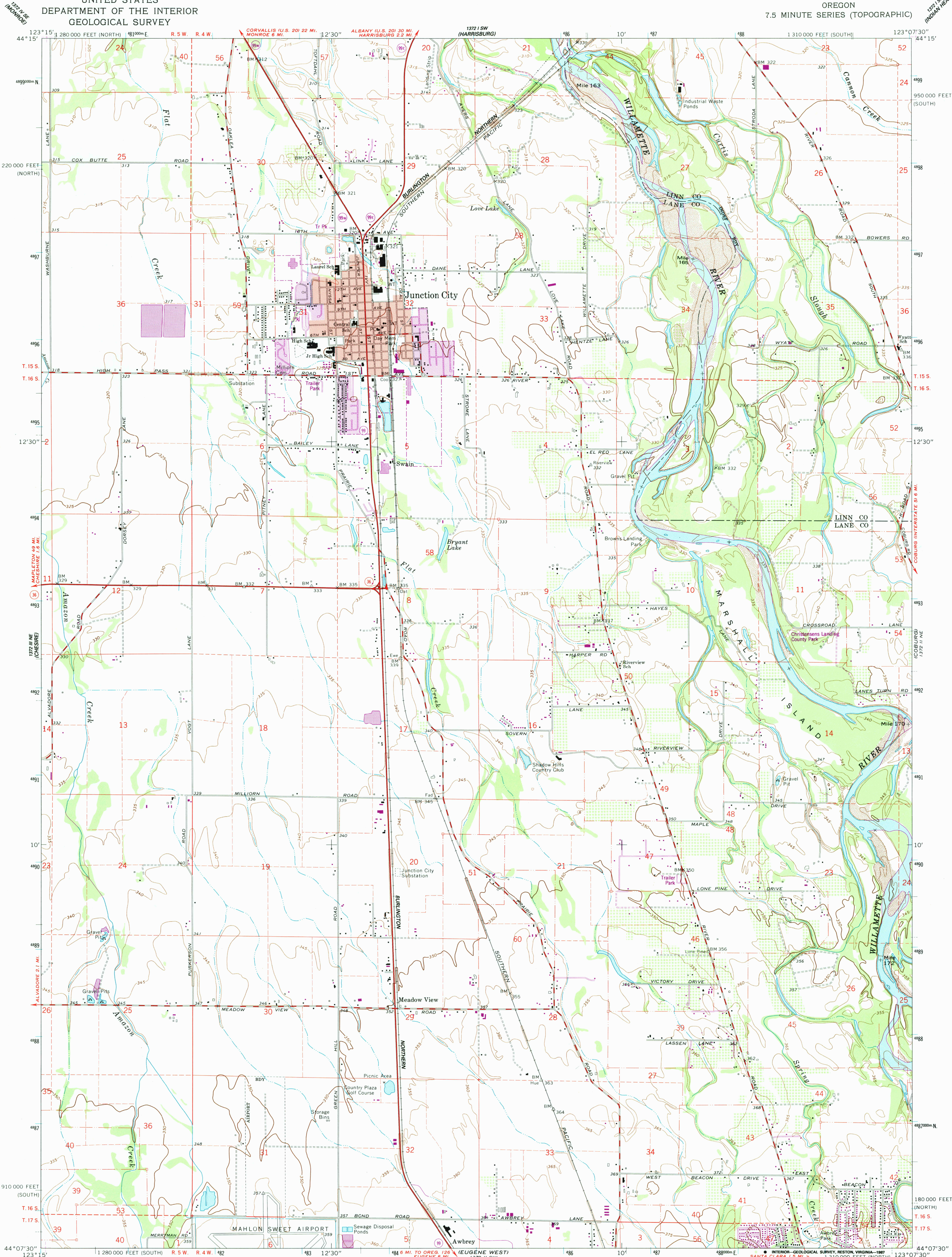

95 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
Red tint indicates areas in which only landmark buildings are shown
Purple tint indicates extension or urban areas
