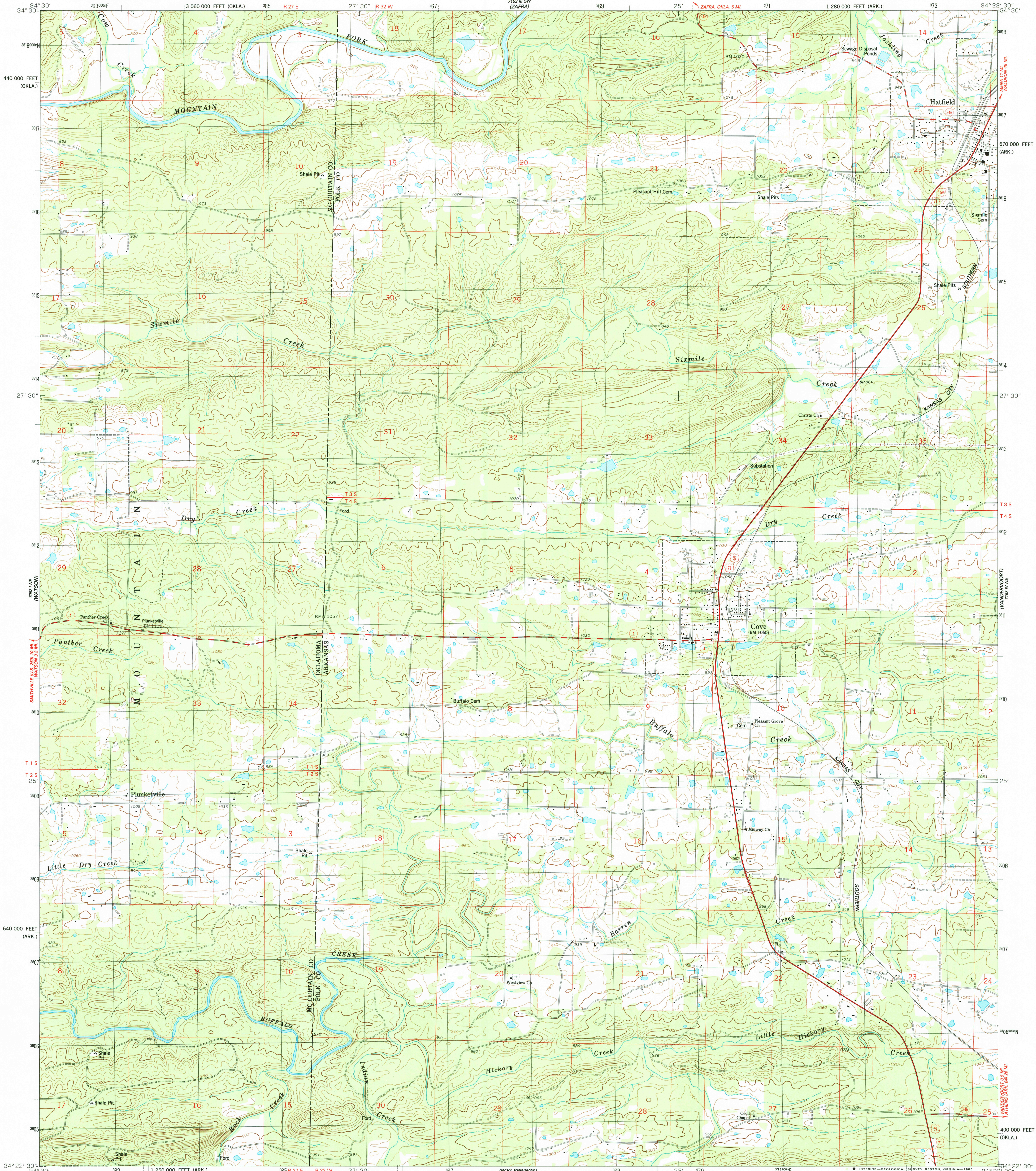

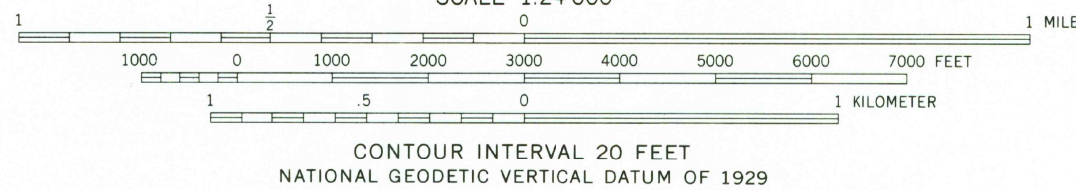
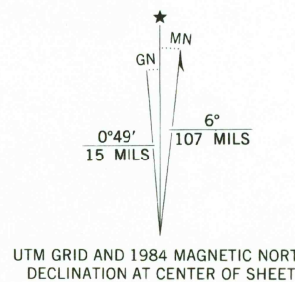
10,000-foot grid ticks based on Arkansas coordinate system, south zone and Oklahoma coordinate system, south zone
