


Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum. 10,000-foot grid based on Michigan coordinate system, south zone 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 17, shown in blue. Red tint indicates areas in which only landmark buildings are shown. To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983, move the projection lines 7 meters west as shown by dashed corner ticks.
