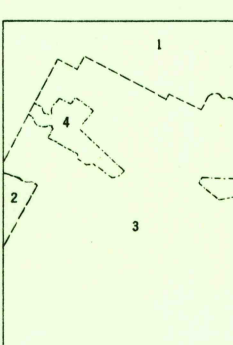
THOUSAND YARD U. S. POLYCONIC GRID, ZONE A
