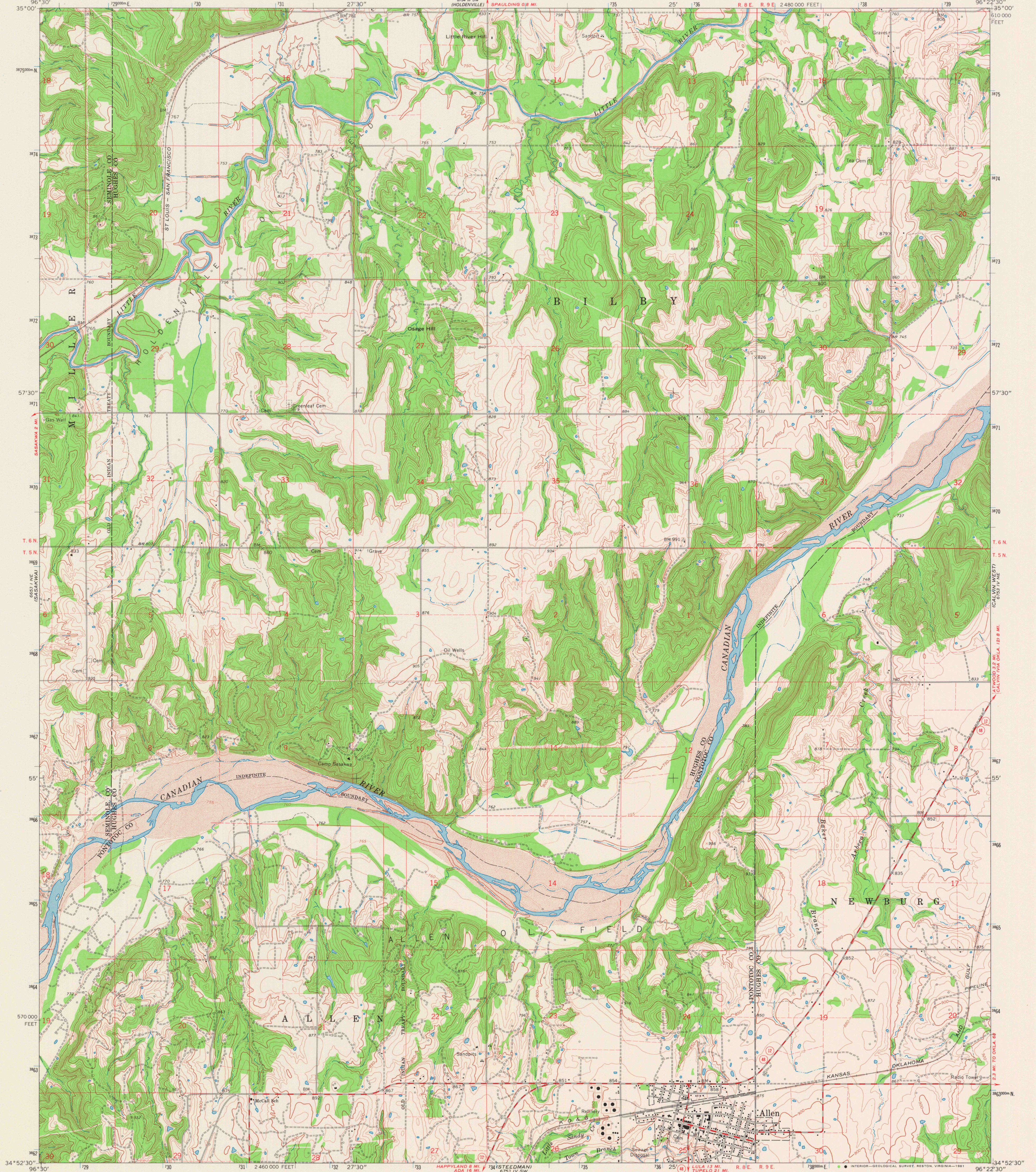

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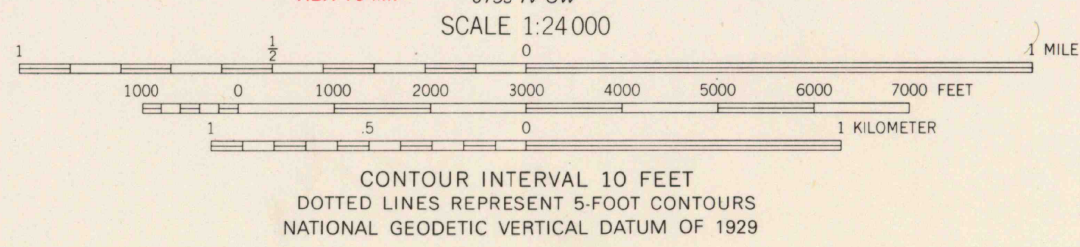
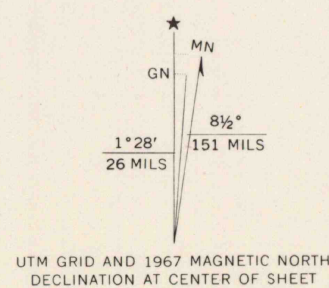
Topography by photogrammetric methods from aerial photographs taken 1966. Field checked 1967

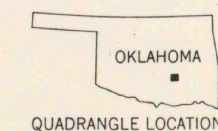
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 5 meters south and 25 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
