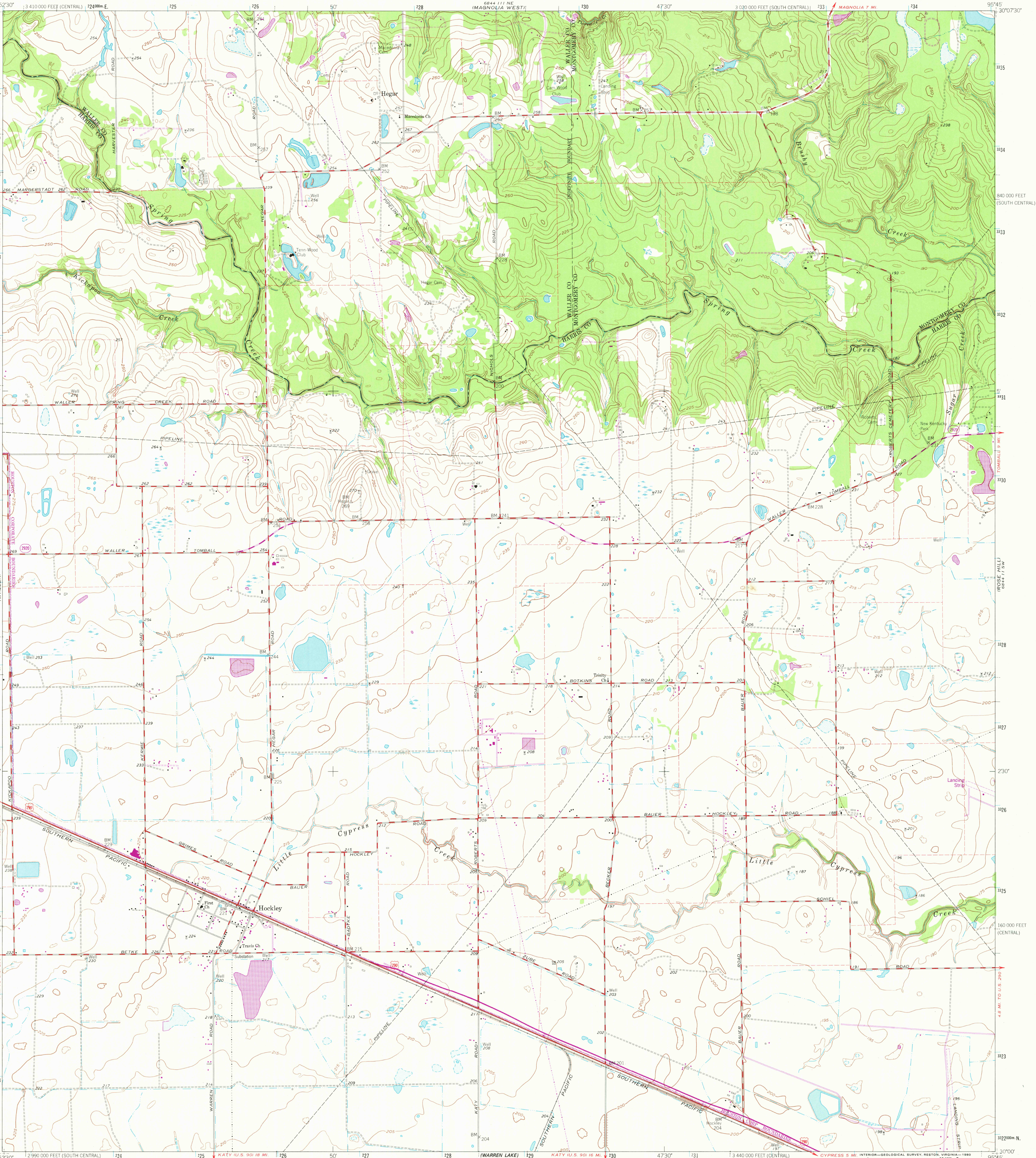

zone 15, shown in blue

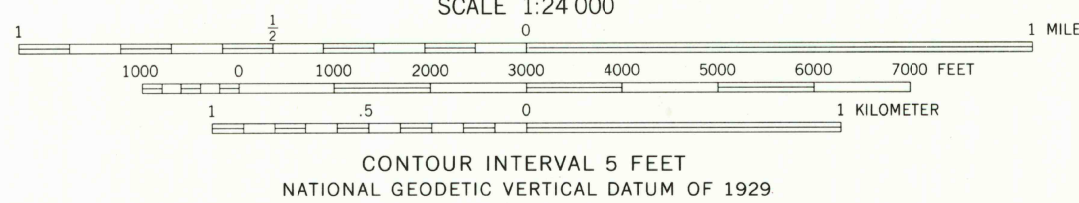
Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence lines
