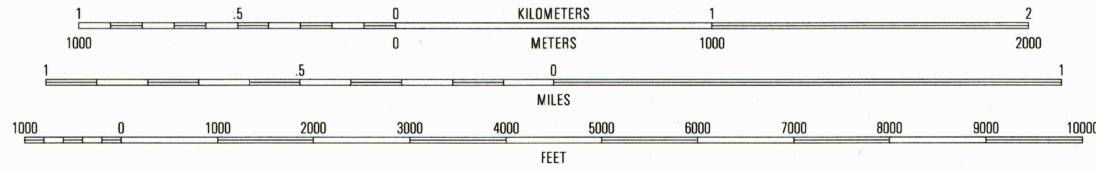
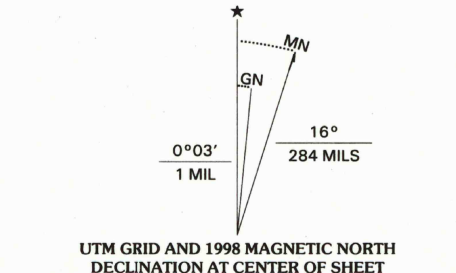

THE AVERAGE RANGE OF TIDE IS APPROXIMATELY 4 FEET

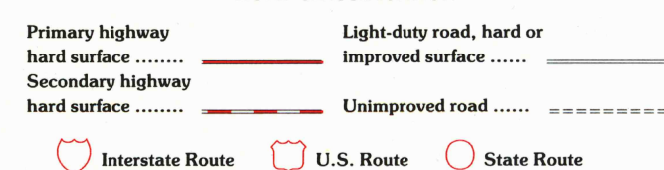
