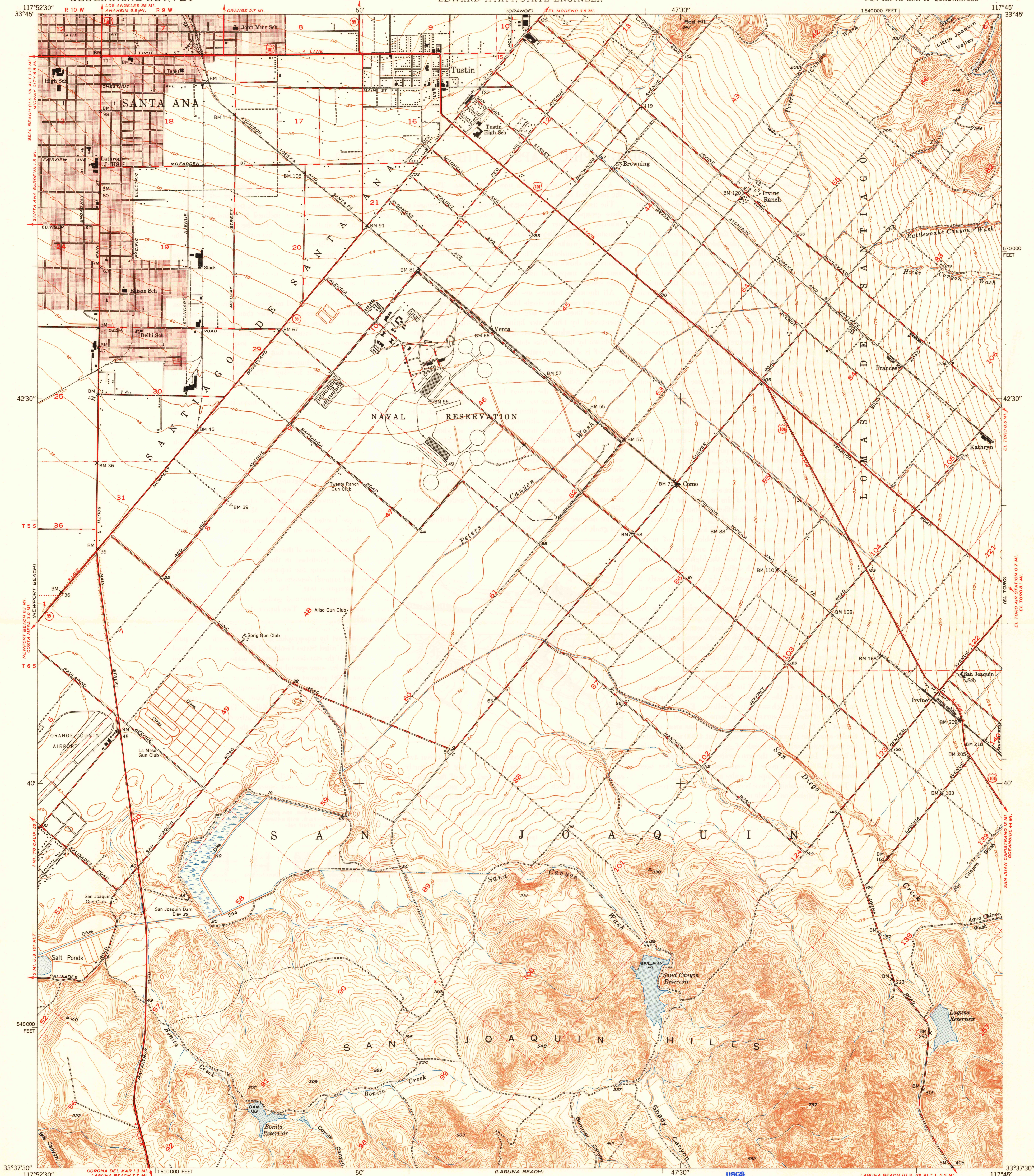

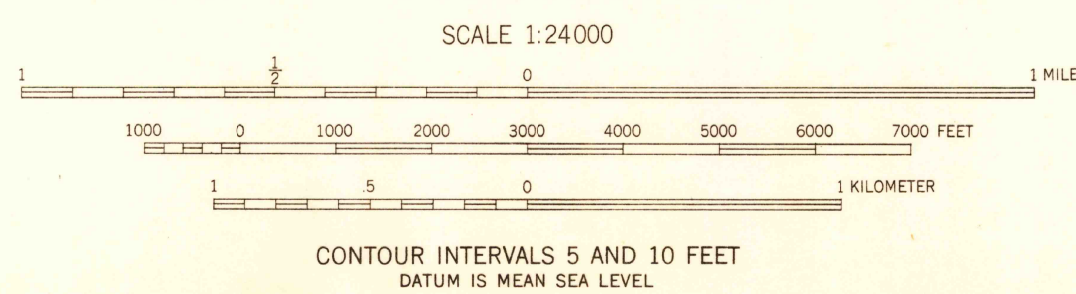
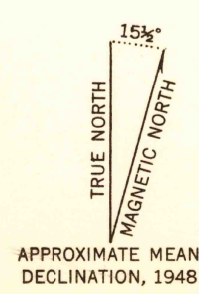

zone 6

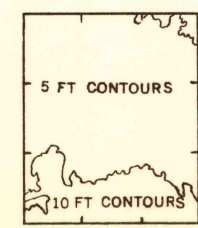
Red tint indicates areas in which only
