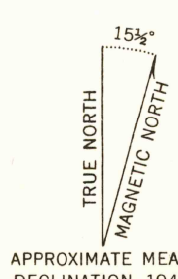

Dashed land lines indicate approximate location

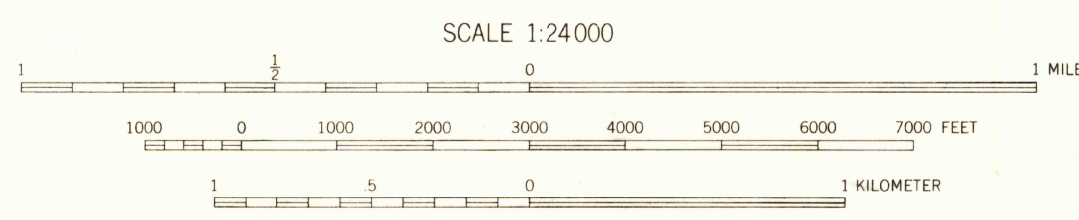
Section lines within land grants were established by private survey
