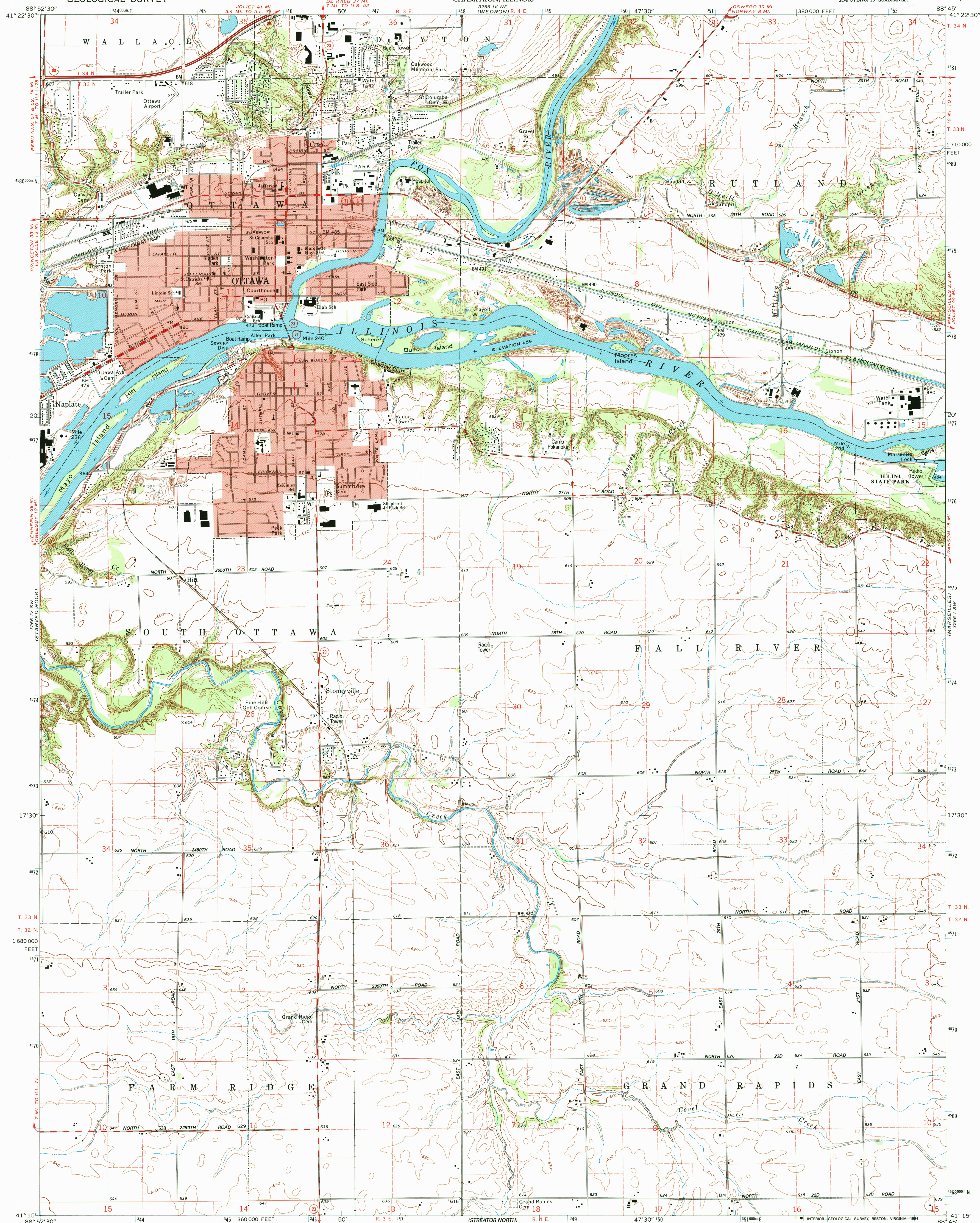

SEA/4 OTTAWA 15' QUADRANGLE



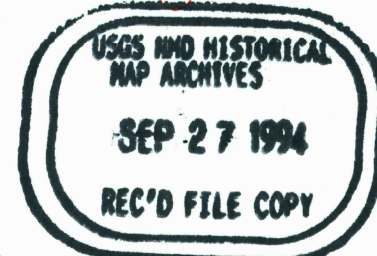
