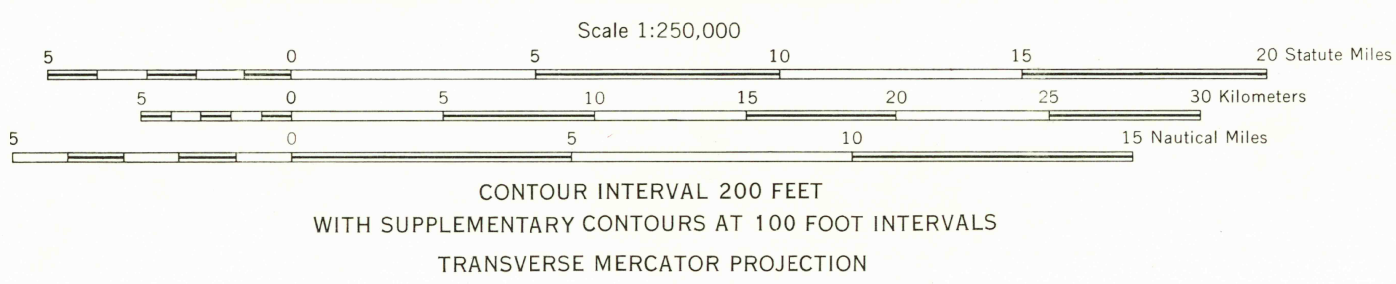
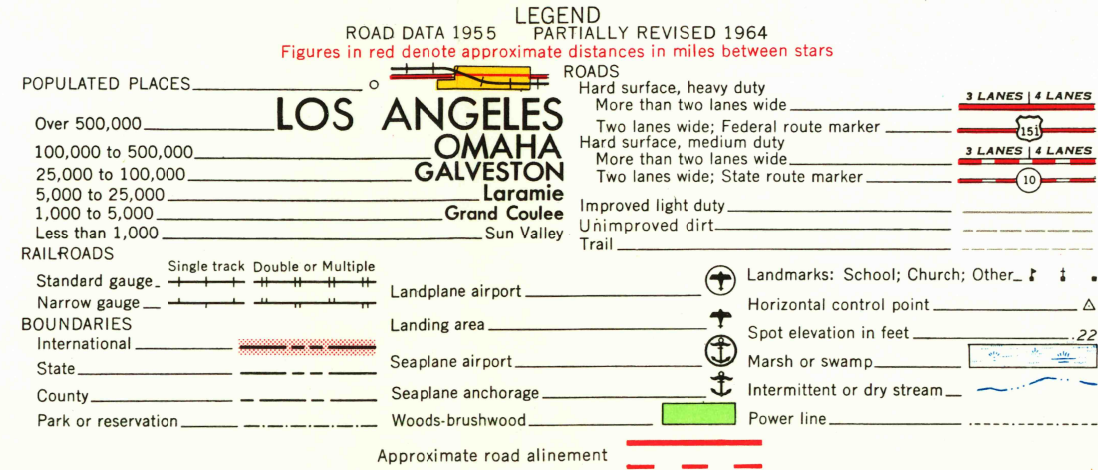

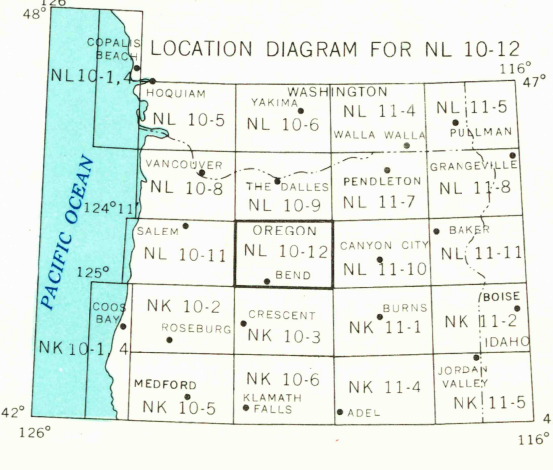
100,000-foot grids based on Oregon Coordinate system, north and south zones.
