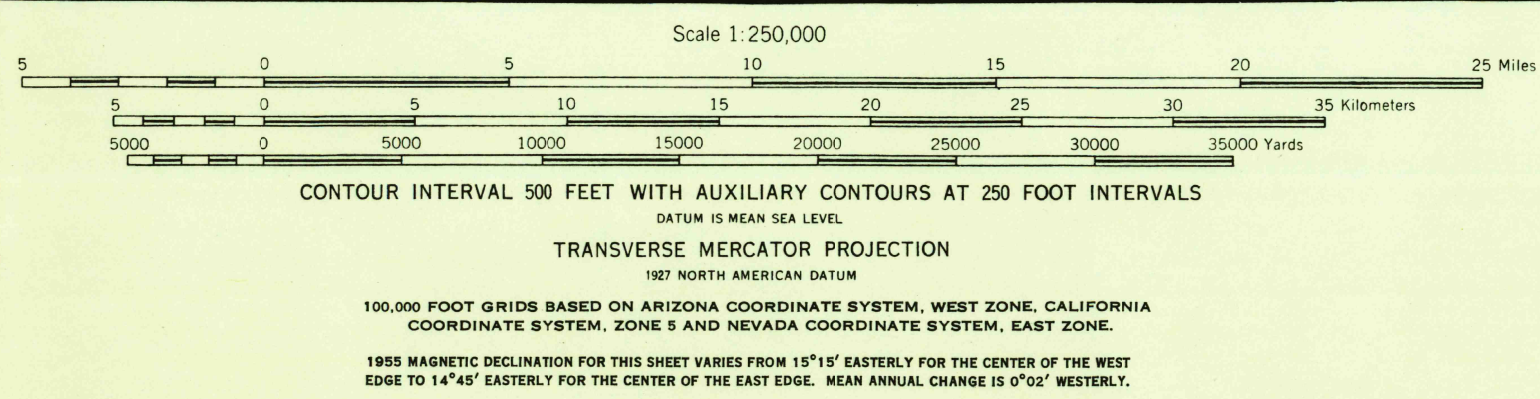
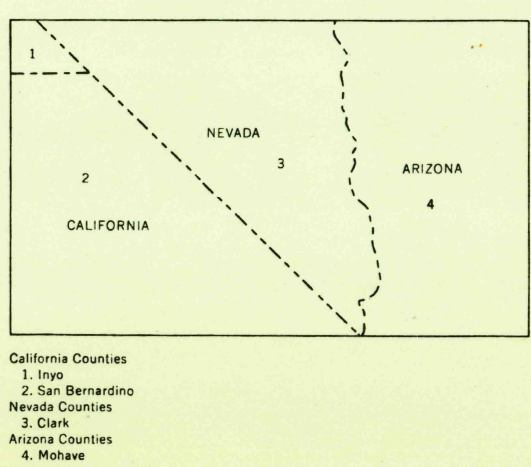

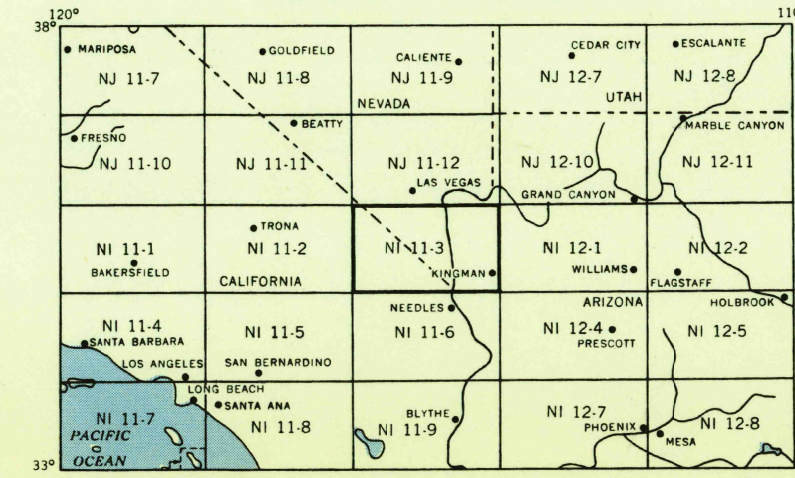
INDEX TO BOUNDARIES

LOCATION DIAGRAM FOR NI 11-3



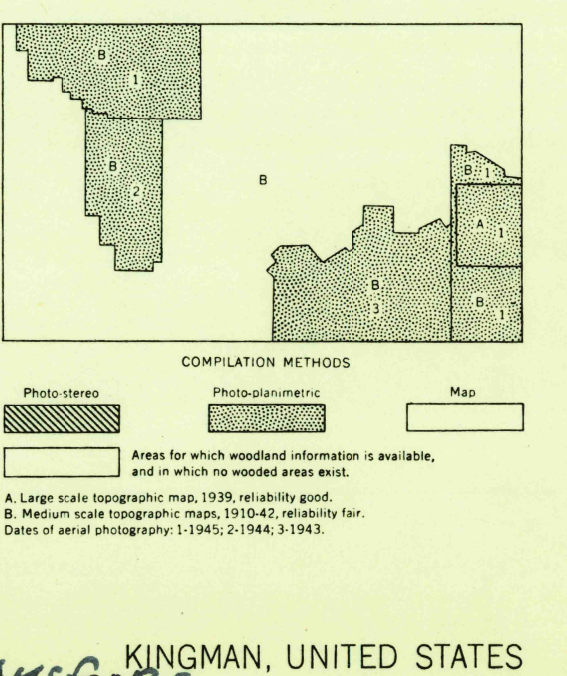
