10,000-foot grids based on Arizona coordinate system, east and central zones

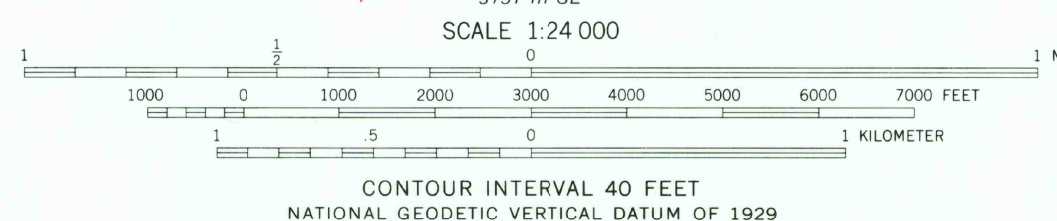
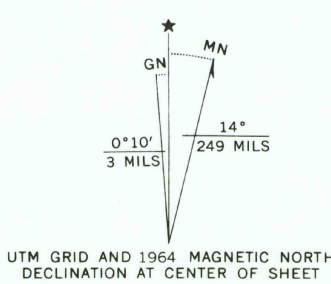
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 12, shown in blue
