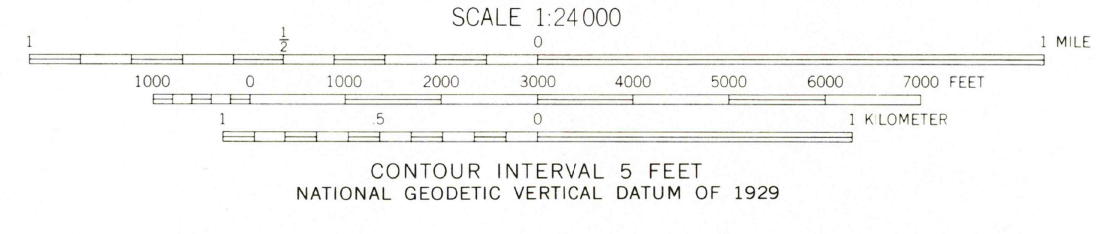
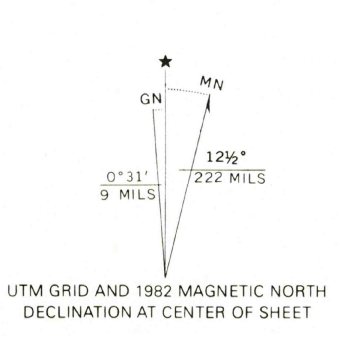

64 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
Certain land lines are omitted because of insufficient data
The southwest portion of this map lies within a subsidence area
Vertical control based on latest available adjustment
There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of
the National or State reservations shown on this map
