To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983,

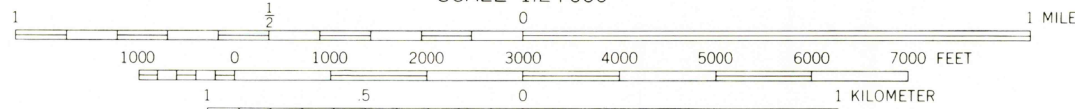
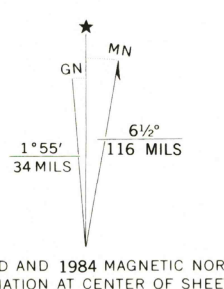
move the projection lines 4 meters north and
