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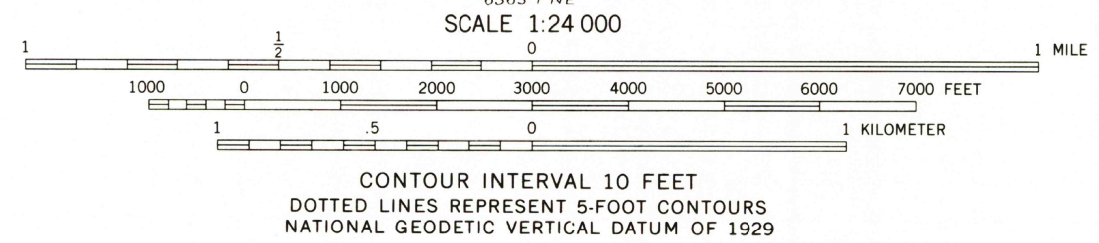
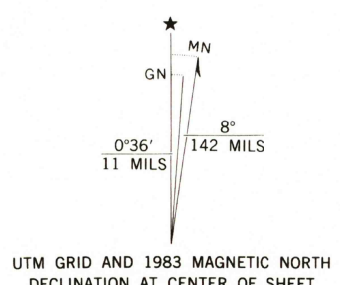
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Topography of Nebraska area by photogrammetric methods from aerial photographs taken 1973. Field checked 1974
Topography of Kansas area by photogrammetric methods from aerial photographs taken 1967. Revised from aerial photographs taken 1973. Field checked 1974

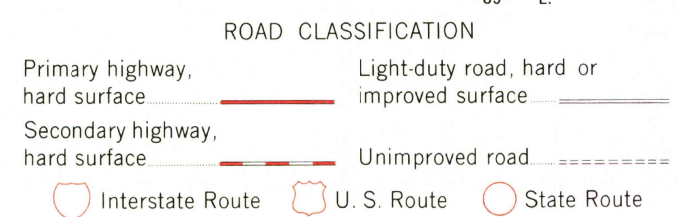
