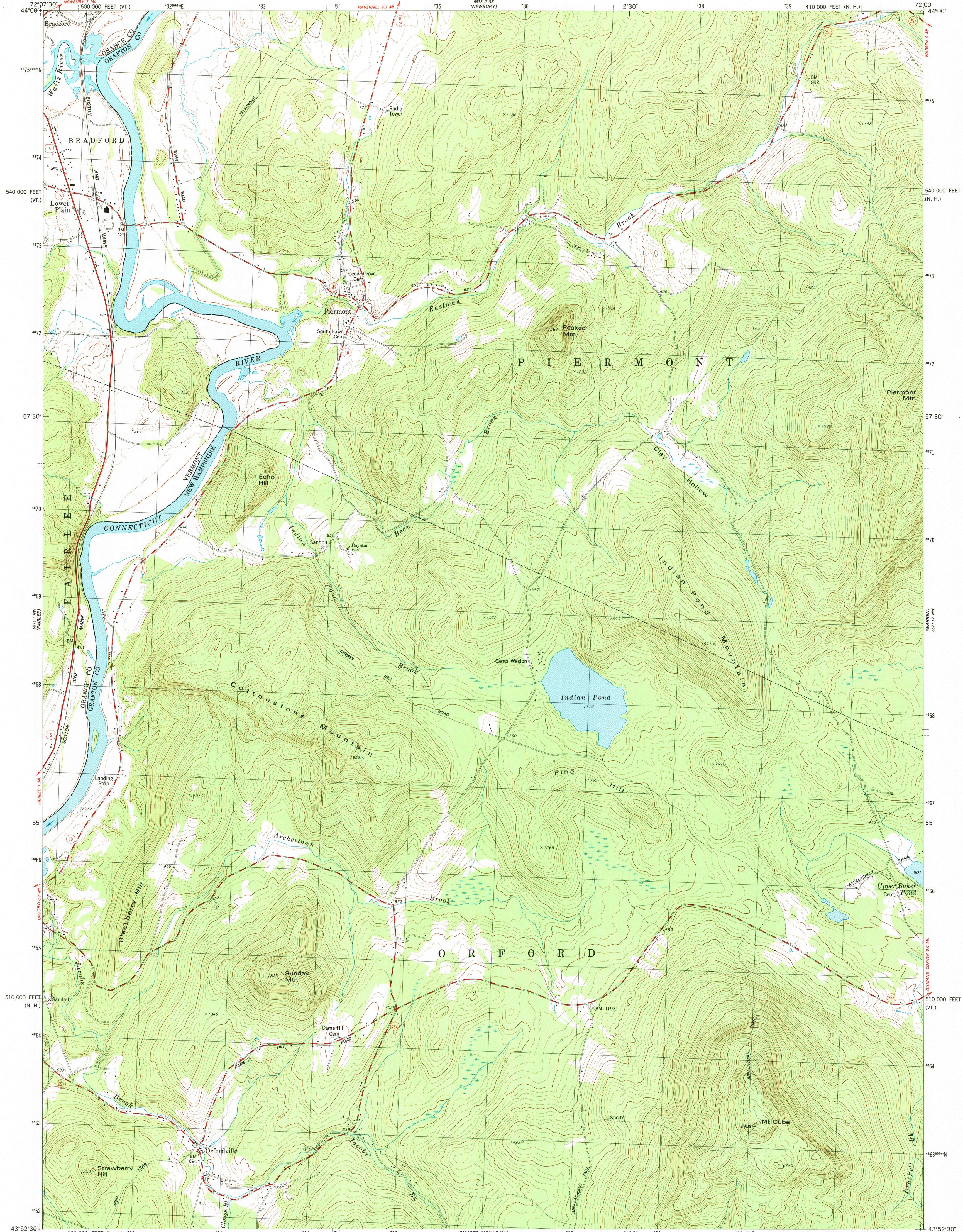

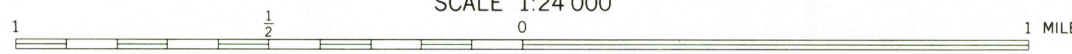
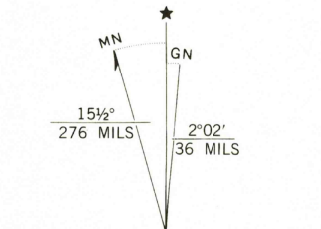
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid, zone 18

No major culture or drainage changes observed



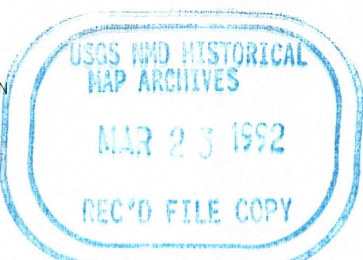
