

Projection and 10,000-foot grid ticks: Louisiana coordinate system, south zone (Lambert conformal conic)  
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid, zone 15 1927 North American Datum  
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983, move the projection lines 17 meters south and 13 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks  
Red tint indicates area in which only landmark buildings are shown  
Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where generally visible on aerial photographs. This information is unchecked
