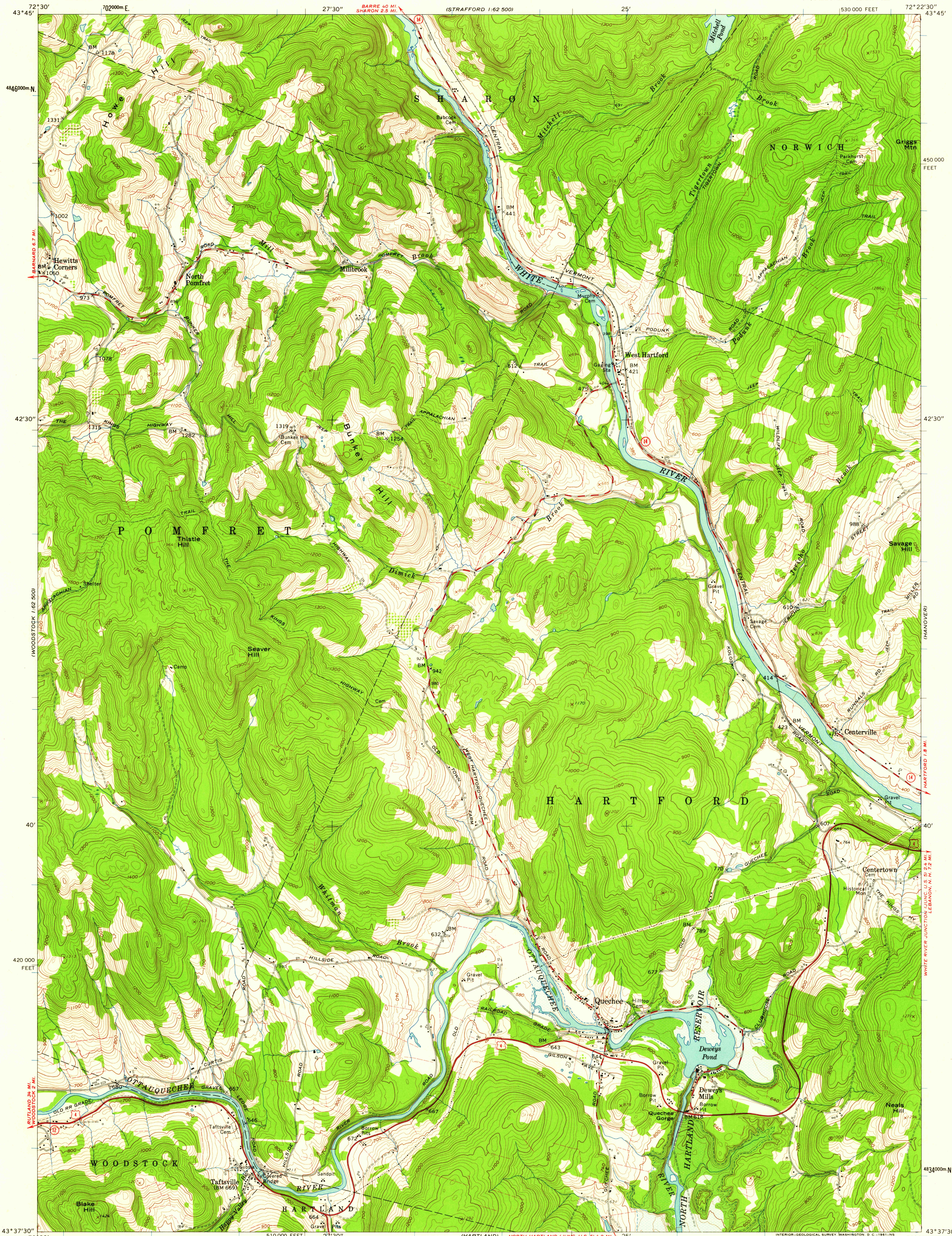
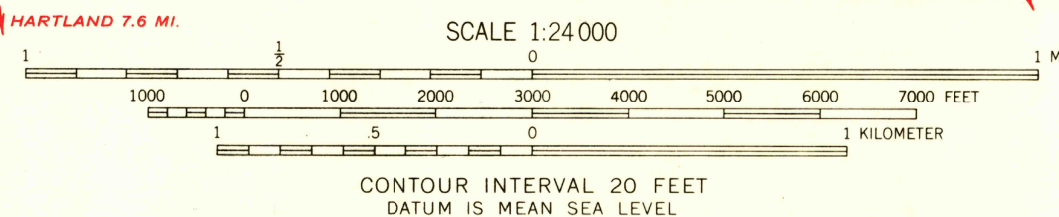

is subject to controlled inundation to 567 feet

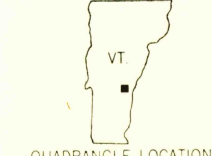


APPROXIMATE MEAN
