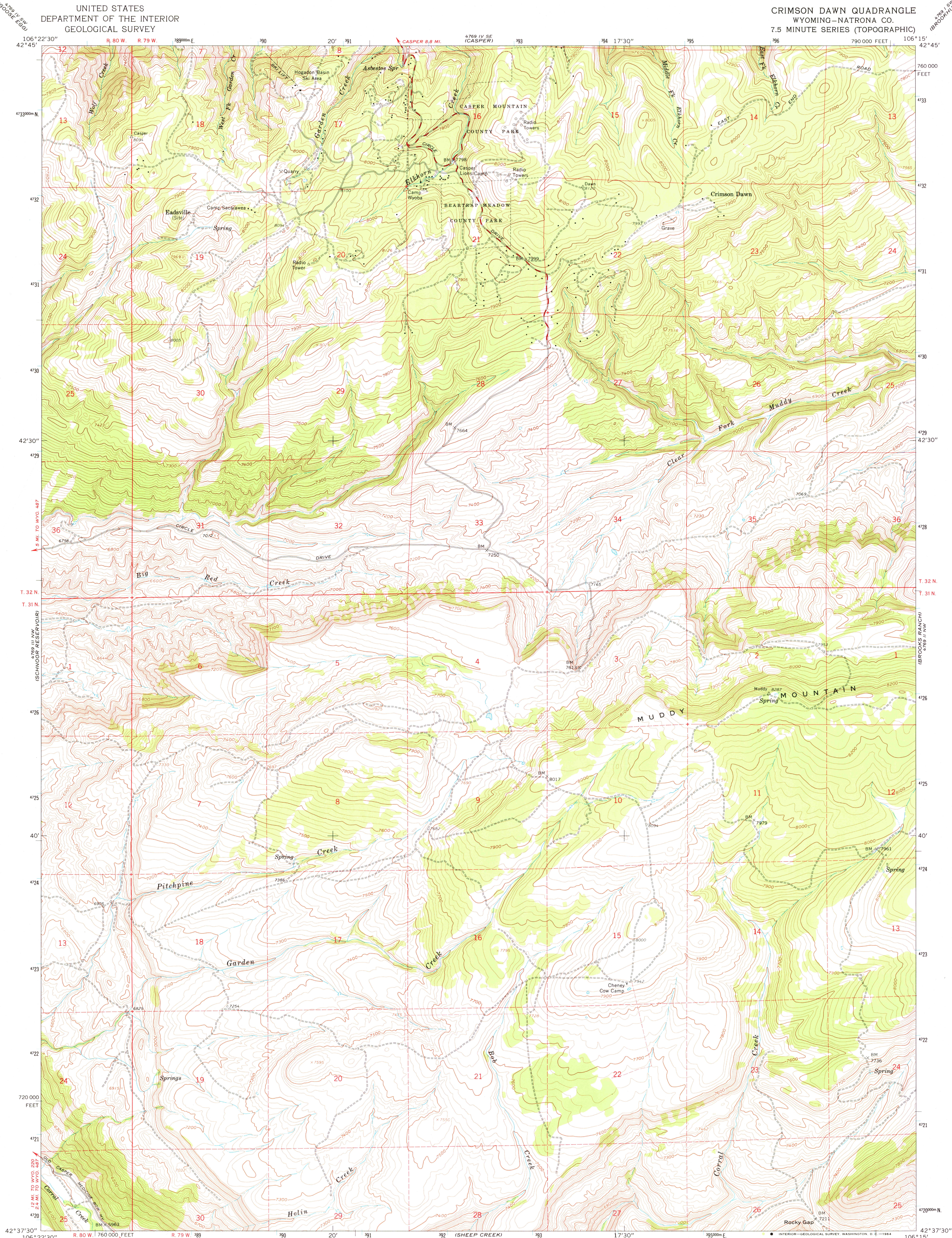

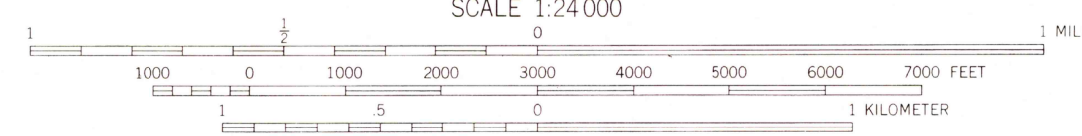

Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where generally visible on aerial photographs. This information is unchecked

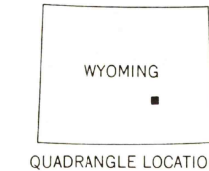
UTM GRID AND 1960 MAGNETIC NORTH DECLINATION AT CENTER OF SHEET
