Polyconic projection. 10,000-foot grid ticks based on Florida coordinate system, east zone


1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 17, shown in blue

1927 North American Datum


To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 34 meters south and 22 meters west and shown by dashed corner ticks
