

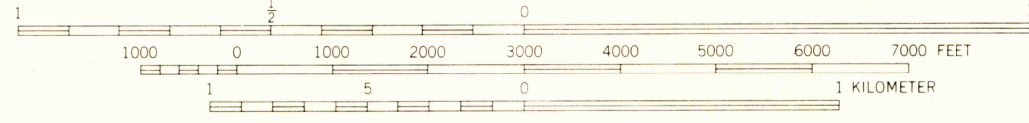
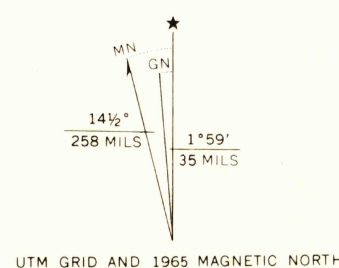

Area covered by dashed light-blue pattern are subject to controlled inundation

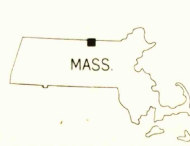
