

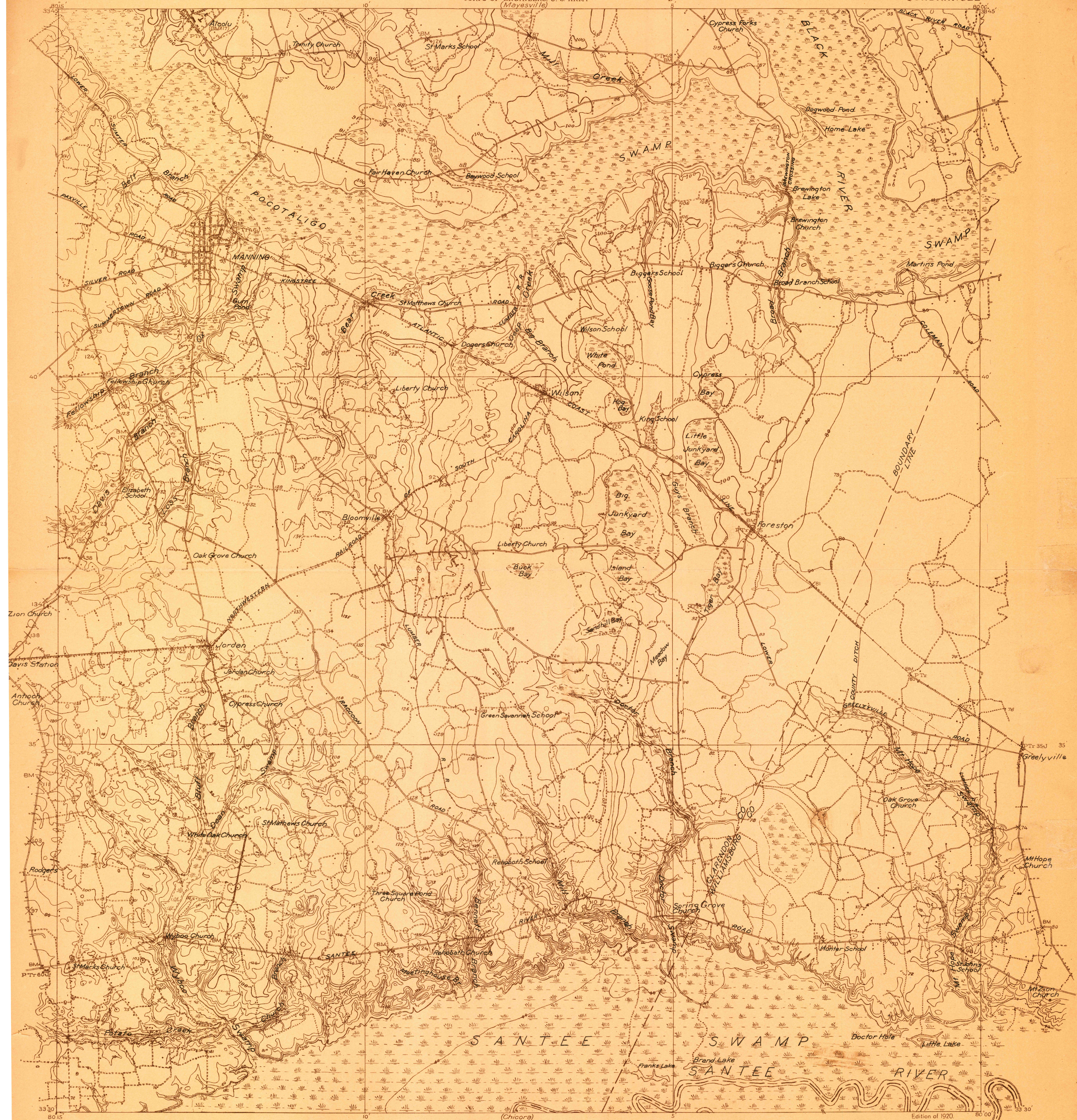

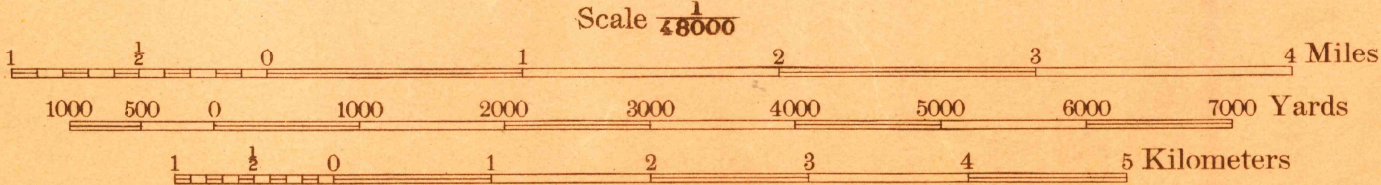
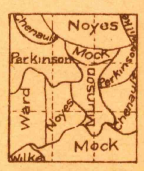

MANNING QUADRANGLE



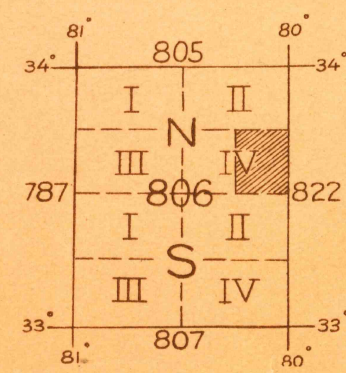
