

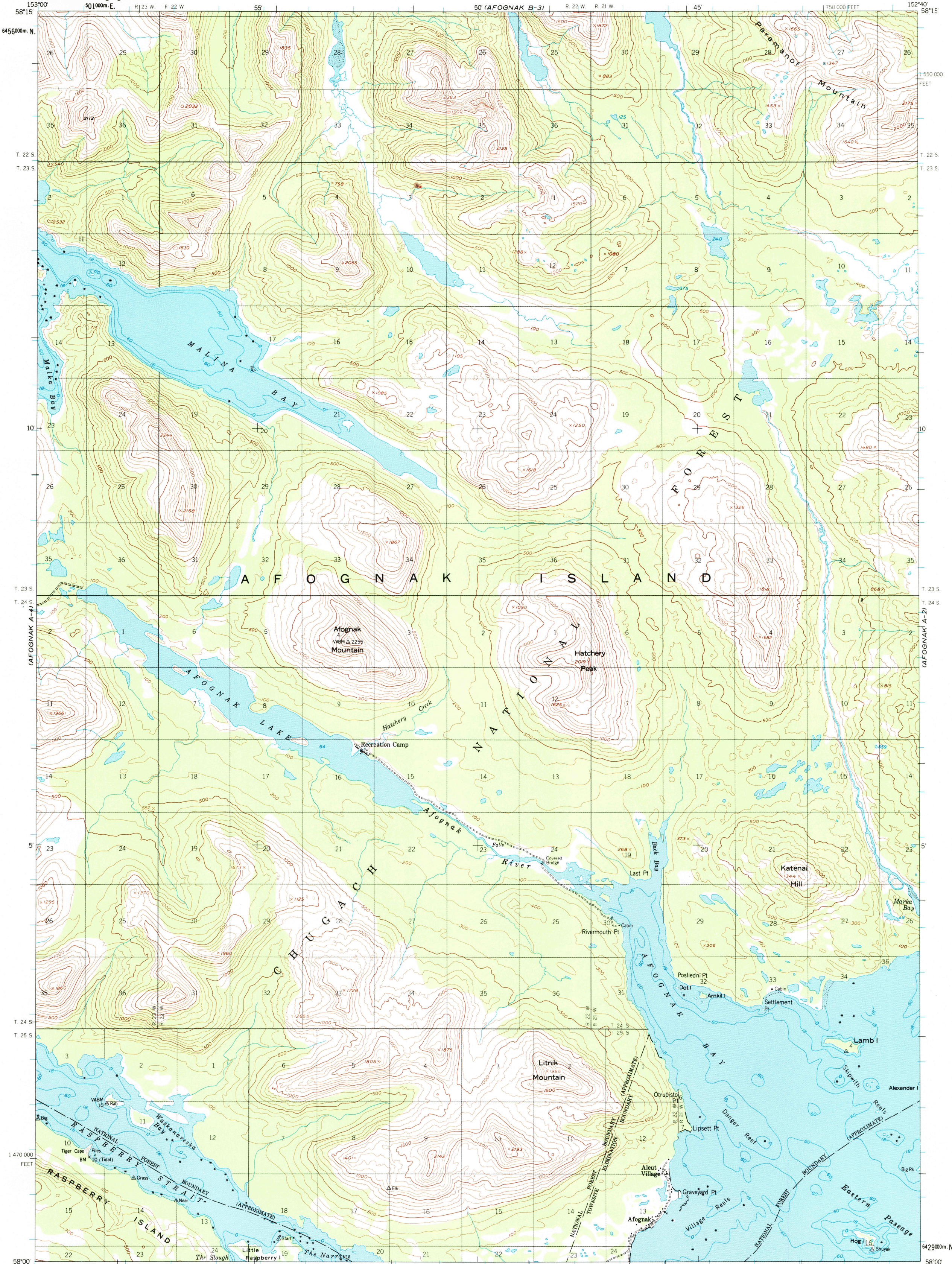

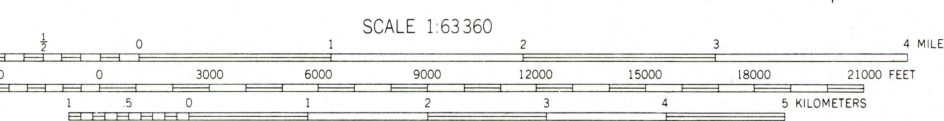
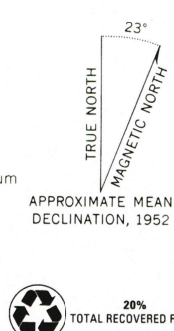
AFOGNAK (A-3) QUADRANGLE
